One of the votes held at the meeting was whether to actively seek a venue for an in-person meeting (as an active expression of our 1st Amendment Rights) or defer to a "virtual-only" format. The vote was 18 to 8 in favor of the 1st Amendment. (I voted as one of the 18.) A committee to expeditiously explore and implement plans for the in-person meeting was created. Once details are known, those will be communicated to you but for now please keep that January 9 date open. I am also on the MCRC Bylaws Committee and will provide you with a report on proposed Bylaw changes in the near future.
