Welcome and introduction of new people

Dennis welcomed everyone and thanked them for their continued dedication to the health and well-being of the Barren River area community. He stated that this new assessment and planning cycle was the Council's opportunity to build on the foundation we have created. He described the meeting as a time to celebrate our accomplishments and continue to explore how community health might be changed as we do things differently.

Our Process for Fall 2014 and Winter 2015

Dennis used a slide presentation to review the Council's process from fall 2011 through summer 2014 and implementation of the Community Health Plan. (slides attached) He reviewed a breakout of factors affecting BRADD health outcomes (40% Social and Economic; 30% Health Behaviors; 20% clinical Care; and 10% Physical Environment).

Results of a member survey were presented:

- 79% of members wishing to move forward to address our 5 Priority Health Issues, and 21% wishing to revisit the data to consider new possible health issues. After discussion, Dennis agreed to revisit the possibility of new health issues during the October meeting.
- 93% of Council members had agreed that we should begin developing a budget for the Council's work.
- 91% of members had agreed that the Sustainability & Marketing Committee should begin exploring registration of the Council as a 501-c-3 organization.

Dennis covered Old Business pending for the Council:

- Continued implementation of the 2013-15 Community Health Plan
- Sustainability and Marketing Plan development and implementation
- Development of Consensus Gold Standards for ideal situations within each stakeholder domain
- A plan and specifications for a Council website.

and New Business:

- Refining our Health Status Indicators (long, medium, and short-term indicators)
- New assessment activities, following up on the priority issues identified during the July meeting, and exploring issues related to the Gold Standards.
- Development of the next Community Health Plan

Long-term and Medium Term Goals

Dennis stated that it was time to reestablish long-term and medium-term outcomes for our 5 Priority Health Issues, as we begin a new assessment and planning process. He asked that each Stakeholder Workgroup use the worksheet provided to begin listing outcomes that could be reworded and finalized during the planning process, but that would lead us to evaluating change. As a starting point, he reviewed the list of state level goals and objectives that had been set by the KYHealthNow 2019 committee. Workgroups also utilized an update of local and state health indicators for the 5 Priority Health Issues, and for selected health behaviors.
