As the restrictions from the pandemic loosen and we increase our family gatherings and other activities, noise violation complaints may increase in the City. Be a good neighbor and know the noise ordinance!

Unless there is a specific contract agreement, the City of Painesville established a noise ordinance to help keep the City a pleasant place to live and visit. Some of the restrictions are listed below, and the entire ordinance can be found online at <https://bit.ly/3fcCexd>.

- Domestic power tools, such as lawnmowers, mechanical saws, grinders and drills, may not be operated outdoors between the hours of 9:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m., or on Saturday or Sunday before 8:30 a.m. Powered snow removal equipment is an exception.
- Construction, drilling or demolition equipment may not be used between the hours of 9:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. if the noise creates a disturbance across a property boundary, except in an emergency.
- Non-commercial loudspeakers and public address systems may not be operated between the hours of 9:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. such that the sound creates a disturbance across a property boundary.
- Air conditioners and generators (among other such appliances) may not be maintained in a manner as to create a noise disturbance across a residential property boundary.

In addition to these fairly specific restrictions, the ordinance also states: "no person shall unreasonably make, continue or cause to be made, continued or permitted, any noise disturbance." An example of this would be loud, disruptive music coming from a residence at any time.

There are also restrictions on the amount of noise that may be generated between 7:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m. for the testing of emergency signaling devices, please refer to the ordinance for further information.

The restrictions listed above are some of the common issues that cause complaints submitted to City staff. Each complaint

# Lakeland Community College's 54<sup>th</sup> Commencement by the Numbers

Lakeland Community College held its 54th annual commencement with Ohio Governor Mike DeWine serving as the keynote speaker. The event was held virtually on the college's YouTube channel Saturday, May 8, at 10 a.m.

"Throughout this past academic year, our faculty, staff and students have demonstrated a tremendous amount of courage in the face of uncertainty. This is especially true of the more than 700 graduates whose accomplishments we

celebrated during our virtual commencement ceremony," said Lakeland President **Morris W. Beverage Jr.** "It couldn't be more fitting that we had our governor address graduates about the value of perseverance, strength and resolve when faced

with obstacles and unexpected challenges."

## 2021 commencement highlights include:

- A total of 761 students received degrees; 57 will earn multiple degrees.
- The oldest graduate is 65; the youngest is 15; seven graduates are 55 years of age and older.
- 63 College Credit Plus students (56 seniors, five juniors, two sophomores) representing 18 high schools graduated.
- 26 are military veterans.
- 124 are first generation college graduates.
- Holden University Center graduates from partner institutions number 108

undergraduate and 62 graduate students.

• Lakeland's highest honor, the Distinguished Service Award, for a member of the community was presented to Kenneth J. Quiggle (2020) and David A. Kalina (2021), for their years of service to the college as members of the board of trustees.



# Bankruptcy 101:

*You are Not Your Credit Score*

**Question:** What is your credit score and why do the lenders make such a big deal about it? How will it affect me in these times?

**Answer:** Back in the 1950's a company called the Fair Isaac Corp. (FICO) developed a formula which was marketed as a way for lenders to realistically evaluate their risk with regard to lending to a specific person. FICO assigned mathematical quantities to patterns of behavior (like how often one pays late, whether they have unsatisfied legal judgments, etc.) and computes those quantities

into a numerical risk factor which is known as our "credit rating." FICO sells people's credit ratings to lenders based on their FICO formula which is a trade secret and legally protected.

There are other companies like FICO which have come up with their own secret form of credit rating which they also sell to credit reporting agencies such as Equifax, Transunion and TRW. In my mind, these companies secrecy causes me to question their integrity and the efficacy of their formulas. FICO should willingly disclose the science behind their mathematical formula so it can be challenged and discussed. It only seems fair that a rating factor which affects so many people's

lives, whether it be for getting credit, a job, security clearance or the trust of another person, should be open to investigation. How do we really know its not complete voodoo?

There is a widely held belief that FICO and the entire individual credit rating system was developed by the elite to keep the middle class in their place. "Their place" is presumably in a constant state of fear over their financial rating willing to pay the banks any interest rate or penalty without question.

In our bankruptcy practice, we spend a large portion of our time helping people get back on financial track. I see people

regularly who enter my office in a state of hopelessness and are healthy, happy, laughing and spirited six months down the line. Bankruptcy stays on your credit for ten years. But my response to that is "So what?" Anybody who really wants to get credit and buy another house can do it in three years or better. Even with a very low credit rating. They will have to be creative nowadays. But that is a topic for a different day. So the focus should not be on your credit rating but on your ability to pay back a specific amount of a loan within a specific period of time. I tell our bankruptcy clients: "yes, try to get a loan you can afford as soon as possible

and pay it back early. This is the beginning of your life of financial responsibility."

The "fresh start" that one can receive, often times, through bankruptcy is extremely valuable in terms of peace of mind and freedom from stress. 


