FROM THE PRESIDENT

Ransom E. Olds began the Olds Motor Vehicle Company in 1897, six years before Ford Motors started making automobiles. Even though he had a head start, a warehouse fire destroyed many of Olds' prototypes. Fortunately, two employees managed to rescue the curved dash Oldsmobile model, which became the first ever mass produced gasoline powered car. At first the cars were called Old Automobiles, but soon became known as Oldsmobiles. They became a household name through songs like the 1905 Standard, "In My Merry Oldsmobile," by Billy Murray. One Oldsmobile achievement worth noting was the first mass produced Rocket V8 engine. Invented in 1949, it considerably boosted performance and paved the way for modern engines. Experts tell us Oldsmobile's peak began during the 1960s with the release of the Cutlass, a streamlined, best-selling car with a trailblazing Rocket V8 engine. But sales declined sharply 30 years later, when Japanese import car companies slowly pushed Oldsmobile out. Oldsmobile shut down in 2004. When it did, it was the oldest surviving American automobile brand, and it was one of the oldest in the world. I hope you enjoy hearing stories like this as much as I do. I never tire of a great automotive history lesson.

Spring has Sprung and the car shows and cruise-ins have started. Even though we were out of town, I heard that the Kiokee Cruise-In was amazing (as it always is). The cruise-ins at French Market are starting this Saturday and will continue through the warm weather. Keep an eye
