## **MIDDLE SCHOOL CLINICIAN**

**VICTOR DJONORH** is the Head Band Director at Summit Middle School and Associate Band Director at Santa Fe High School in Edmond, Oklahoma. Djonorh is a graduate of Carl Albert High School and Oklahoma City University. He is currently in his ninth year of public education and serving his thirteenth year maintaining his private teaching studio. His teaching duties include beginning brass and flute, 7th grade brass and woodwinds, 8th grade band, high school marching band, and high school chamber music. Under the direction of Mr. Djonorh, the Summit Middle School Bands frequently receive Superior Ratings at OSSAA District Contest and many of the students from these ensembles are selected for the CODA Regional Honor Band each year. In addition to his daily teaching schedule, he serves as the team lead for Elective Classes at Summit Middle School. In 2020, Mr. Djonorh was selected as Teacher of the Year at Summit.

Mr. Djonorh's private studio includes students from 6th through 12th grade and consistently produces All-Region and All-State players with ten students receiving such honors this past audition season. Several past students have also gone on to continue in music at universities across the country.

Mr. Djonorh is a member of Central Oklahoma Bandmasters Association (CODA), Oklahoma Bandmasters Association (OBA), Oklahoma Music Educators Association (OkMEA), and International Tuba Euphonium Association (ITEA).

## HIGH SCHOOL CLINICIAN

Native Oklahoman, **SUSAN CLOTHIER** has enjoyed incomparable success as a distinguished music educator, trumpeter, conductor, adjudicator, clinician, consultant, accompanist, and music minister for 4 decades. She holds a MM from Hardin-Simmons University and attended Oklahoma City University for her Undergraduate Studies. Her teaching career took her throughout Oklahoma to Washington, Tuttle, Tecumseh, and back home to Oklahoma City where she spent the final 19 years of her teaching career at Putnam City North High School. She was named Teacher of the Year in every school in which she served.

A true pioneer in her field, she was the first female director of the Falls Creek Baptist Assembly Band, a post which she held for 26 years. She also served as the Instrumental music consultant for OK Baptist General Convention, served as Conductor of the Oklahoma Baptist All State Youth Orchestra for several years, and was on the planning committee and initial auditions for The Oklahoma Baptist Symphony. In addition to these significant accomplishments, Susan has received the highest of awards, having been named Band Director of the Year and inducted into the Oklahoma BandMasters Hall of Fame. She has served as the District Coordinator of Bands for Putnam City Schools and was the Fine Arts Department Chair for Putnam City North High School. She currently directs the "Friends" Band consisting of Senior adults and is Minister of Music and Worship at Highland Hills Baptist Church in Oklahoma City. She received the Outstanding Service Award to Oklahoma Small School Bands from the Oklahoma Small School Band Directors Association, for which she also served as the inaugural president. She was recently inducted in the Oklahoma Music Educators Hall of Fame.

In addition to a life-long appreciation and enjoyment of music, her student successes include professional musicians in Broadway Shows, Symphony Orchestras, Theater Orchestras Chanticleer, DFW Brass, Military Bands, University Professors, and teachers in prominent music classrooms everywhere.

Now semi-retired, Ms. Clothier, lovingly known by her students as "Ms. C", serves as a clinician, instrumental consultant and educational representative for Palen Music Center. Her love of visiting band rooms will never end! She enjoys reading and spending time with her dogs Judy and J.D.
