

**PROGRESS CONTINUES TO BE MADE ON PRAYER SHRINE DEDICATED TO THE MYSTERIES OF THE ROSARY**  
***El Santuario de Los Pobladores – The Sanctuary of the Settlers, invite supporters of this undertaking to stop by the site to see the progress made. Adobe walls fashioned by hard work and zealous determination have gone up and completed. Adding additional warmth and appeal, a large beautiful rustic gate is adorning the entrance to the shrine with three smaller gates at the exits. Bronze art for the individual nichos has also been completed and will be mounted next spring.***  
***At the entrance to the shrine, there will be a 7 foot bronze statue of Our Lady of Guadalupe. Seven surrounding bronze statues of our mission patron saints will bolster the spiritual presence of our faith. Adobe dedication plaques and merchant donor plaques will also be in place. Landscaping and a security system will complete the project. The committee estimates that additional funds to complete the project will be approximately \$250,000. 

**MASS READING REFLECTION**

May 22, 2022  
First Reading—Acts 15:1-2. 22-29  
[Settling a Dispute]


This passage continues the First Reading of last Sunday. Paul and Barnabas had baptized Gentiles without having them circumcised and telling them to observe the law of Moses. Some Christians from Jewish backgrounds did not agree. Hence, Paul and Barnabas decided to go up to Jerusalem and ask the apostles for a decision. Acts 15:3-12 (skipped in this reading) and also Galatians 2:1-14 tell about the procedure. There was a lengthy discussion on the issue now brought out in the open: Should Christianity be a renewal movement in the framework of Judaism, or should it outgrow it to a certain extent? The consensus was that in the spirit of the founder, Jesus Christ, there should be profound renewal, yet also continuity. A compromise was then reached: Gentiles may join the Church by baptism alone and do not have to be circumcised, but they should follow a few laws in order to facilitate social contact with Christians from Jewish background. Note the words: “It is the decision of the Holy Spirit and of us. “Apostolic collegiality is guided by the Spirit! How do you see the renewal of your Church? Notice the three elements: renewal-continuity-guidance of the Holy Spirit! Pray for discernment!

Second Reading Rv 21:10-14, 22-23  
(The City of God)

Utilizing the language of vision, the sacred writer describes the splendor of the Church, seeing the earthly and heavenly Church in one perspective. The language is highly symbolic. The Church has a particular brilliance which is the divine indwelling. In order to understand the symbolism of this passage one must remember that in New Testament thinking the Church is the “Israel of God,” succeeding the “Israel of the flesh.” Thus, the author shows that the Church is a renewed Israel by referring to her as “Jerusalem,” founded on the “the twelve apostles of the Lamb,” who succeed the twelve patriarchs of the Israel of old. In so doing the sacred writer clearly indicates that there is continuity between the old Israel and the Church as well as a distinct aspect of renewal. Hence, in order to be faithful to its mission in the world the Church should renew itself constantly. As long as this is done under the guidance of the Spirit and the continuity of essentials is safeguarded, we should approve with an open mind.

**THEME:**  
**“The Father will send the Holy Spirit in my name.”**

Renewal implies continuity, yet it outgrows the old. The founder of the Ford Motor Company for example, would hardly recognize his own first assembly line if he could see the Ford plants now. Yet basically it is the same. His successors have renewed the process of producing constantly in the spirit of the founder. They would be unfaithful to his great vision if they were still working as he did so many years ago.

The early leaders of the Church, commissioned by our Lord to continue his work on earth, faced a similar problem of renewal and continuity. Should Christianity be a renewal movement in the framework of existing Judaism? There should indeed be continuity, for Jesus had said that he did not intend to do away with the law and the prophets (Mk 5:17). Yet, should Gentiles, who joined the Church, be forced to observe so many Jewish laws, especially those conditioned by time and culture?

Guided by the Spirit, the gift of the risen Lord to his people, the Church has renewed itself over the centuries, and is still doing so. Today's Bible readings deal with this issue.

<p>MOVING FORWARD - USCCB SPRING PLENARY ASSEMBLY</p> <p>Greetings in Our Lord! Following the Spring Plenary Assembly of the USCCB last week, questions have been raised about a vote taken by the bishops to draft a document on the Eucharist.</p> <p>This document on the Eucharist was proposed five years ago as part of the framework of the 2021-2024 USCCB Strategic Plan, <i>Created Anew by the Body and Blood of Christ, Source of Our Healing and Hope</i>. I was a member of the Committee on Priorities and Plans which assisted in its development and final approval.</p> <p><i>"Created Anew is a response to the reality in the Church of declining Mass attendance, religious disaffiliation among Catholics, and the lack of understanding of the real presence of Christ in the Eucharist."</i></p> <p>I ask you to reflect on what this means in your own life and faith. The Eucharist is the gift from God of his son, Jesus, in his body, blood and truth, entering every moment of our lives. It is neither merely a symbol nor a gesture, it is a physical and spiritual relationship, a reality of God alone, closer to us than we are to ourselves. It is our personal encounter with Christ. This reality must cause much prayer, reflection, and conversion in our daily lives. None of us are worthy for this, and all of us need constant conversion.</p> <p>"Questions and Answers on the U.S. Bishops' Vote to Draft a Document on the Meaning of the Eucharist in the Life of the Church" is now available on the USCCB website at <a href="#">Q&amp;A on Eucharist Document.pdf (usccb.org)</a>. From this FAQ sheet you will see that there has been no vote taken by the bishops whether or not to deny certain groups or individuals the Eucharist, nor any intent to produce a national policy aimed exclusively towards any group or individuals, e.g. politicians. The document will include a section on the Church's teaching on the responsibility of <i>every</i> Catholic, including bishops, to live in accordance with the truth, goodness, and beauty of the Eucharist we celebrate. We will continue to emphasize the obligation of all Catholics to support the dignity of human life, from natural conception to natural death and other fundamental principles of Catholic moral and social teaching.</p> <p>The Eucharistic Renewal Project has been in planning for five years. Regardless of others' attempts to reassign its motivation into the political arena, we will be focused on deepening our understanding of and love for the Eucharist. It is time for this renewal, and I am happily anticipating the work ahead. The Holy Spirit will guide our Church through this next important phase as always when we turn to Him as we have done.
