**Grace & Peace** from the Pastor's Desk

#### While I was walking in the town of Watkins Glen over vacation,

...I noticed a phone booth. It was one of the old-fashioned type, painted fire-engine red, with square paneled windows, where you would step into the booth, close the door, and have a private conversation.

I stopped and looked inside of it because I saw a news story in about 2014 saying the last phone booth in the country was being removed. Not the blue ones that were half partitions of plexi-glass, but honest to goodness full phone booths, like the one I was checking out. I have no idea what the purpose of the phone booth was in Watkins Glen, but it was definitely not holding a telephone. ... I don't know why I am fixated with this. Perhaps this means so much to me because of the implication it has. We have grown so accustomed to carrying our own phone with us everywhere we go there is no longer a need for a public phone. Now don't get me wrong, I appreciate having a hand-held computer. But, is this a commentary on our lives? Have we become such an individual centered society?

This brings to mind the passage from Judges 2:10.."After that generation died, another generation grew up who did not acknowledge the Lord or remember the mighty things he had done..." I know it isn't such a big deal that a generation now exists that doesn't know the phone booth... after all, there is much that my parents and grandparents experienced that I never will know about (and am probably grateful for my ignorance). But what truly scares me are the implications here... if we don't start to share our faith with the younger generation in a way that is transparent and authentic, there may well be a generation who does not know the Lord.

In our Christian Education meeting we were discussing ways of trying to bring more children into the church. This is something that we have talked about in different places at different times and we just can't come up with a solution. We're thinking maybe just having more fun time integrated into the class time, maybe do one week a month that isn't classwork. Or perhaps have a short lesson each Sunday and play some sort of game after the lesson. If anyone has any idea we'd really like to hear it. Our intention is not to make the numbers of kids in the classes look better, but to bring more kids to Jesus. Faith may be personal, but it is never private. Faith is like love, it is nothing unless it is shared.

I hope you've had a good summer. And I hope you'll share in our Christian education. I'm planning on holding an adult Sunday school class after worship beginning September 19<sup>th</sup>. It would be great to see you there. And as always, I'm available to talk. I'm in the office Tuesdays and Thursdays from 9:30 a.m. until 2:00 p.m. Stop in, or call 814-833-4062. #### CHURCH COUNCIL UPDATE-CAPITAL CAMPAIGN

At the Congregational Meeting on August 8, 2021, the assembly voted to approve the expenditure for 4 LAARS Mascot boiler units, pumps, piping and labor to replace the failed boiler unit to the Education Wing and to update the existing boiler unit to the Sanctuary. The total cost to replace the boiler system is \$58,803.64.



A Capital Campaign is currently underway to raise funds for the cost

of the new boiler system. A designated fund has been set up. A rummage sale is being considered for a possible Fall date. If you are a Thrivent member you can apply for a grant from the Action Team program as we proceed with our fund raising.
