is a community affiliate of the Saint Paul and Minnesota Community Foundation. We operate as a separate fund under the nonprofit charitable organization status of the Saint Paul Foundation. The independent, volunteer board of Shoreview residents and friends selects grant recipients based on established criteria and is responsible for leadership and fundraising.

The endowment funds of the Shoreview Community Foundation are invested with the Saint Paul Foundation in a balanced fund. There is a small operating fund. Besides investment through the Saint Paul and Minnesota Community Foundations, we receive management support and advice from their experienced staff.

Thanks to generous support from our donors, the Shoreview Community Foundation continued to increase our endowment and provided grants to six community organizations - the most ever! Requests for our support once again far exceeded the dollars we have available to grant.

In May we hosted a reception to thank our major donors and introduce our grant recipients to our supporters.

The Ice Cream Social, in June, held at Commons Park on a concert night, has become a tradition. Board members handed out 600 ice cream sundaes to those attending, and hosted and staffed the very popular Bounce House for young children.

In July the foundation organized a unit in the Slice of Shoreview Parade, and gave out over 1,000 snack bags donated by our local Old Dutch Corporation.

Over 200 enthusiastic supporters joined us at our Evening with Friends dinner in November, and contributed over \$50,000 for our endowment thanks to a challenge grant from benefactor Dr. Tracy Aanenson!
