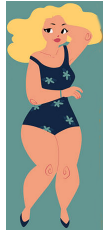
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SSHHHH! IT'S THE GEEZERS!

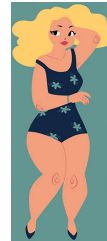
Hey there, don't you know who I am?
