Minimum Acceptable Standards for Signs

Contractor / Advertising Signs:

1. No contractor signs may be placed on the property.

Security Signs:

- 1. Total size of sign alone must not exceed one hundred (100) square inches.
- 2. One sign allowed per lot in front yard.
- 3. Sign must be in good taste i.e. no bright or fluorescent colors allowed on sign.
- 4. Sign must be located in the landscaping, in a discreet location, within four feet (4') of the outside wall of the house, and the location must be approved by the ACC.
- 5. Total sign, including pole, must not exceed eighteen inches (18") in height after installation.
- 6. Sign must be well maintained.

For Sale / For Lease Signs

- 1. Only one (1) sign permitted per lot.
- 2. Sign must not exceed seven (7) square feet in size.
- 3. Sign must never be located in the street right-of-way.
- 4. Sign must be well maintained.
- 5. Must be in good taste, i.e. no bright or fluorescent colors.

Warning Sign: Beware of Dog Sign Only:

- 1. Only one (1) sign permitted on each side of house, maximum two (2) signs per lot.
- 2. Lettering shall not exceed two (2) inches in height, and sign shall not exceed thirty five (35) square inches total.
- 3. Must be well maintained.
- 4. Must be in good taste, i.e. no bright or fluorescent colors.

School Signs: Cheerleader / Sports:

- 1. Total size of sign alone must not exceed four hundred (400) square inches.
- 2. No more than two (2) signs allowed per lot.
- 3. Must be located in landscaping, within four (4) feet of the outside wall of the house.

Political Signs: (Per Property Code § 202.009)

- 1. Residents may display standard campaign signs from 90 days before an election through 10 days after the election.
- 2. Signs must be ground mounted.
- 3. Residents may not display more than one sign for each candidate or ballot item.
- 4. Signs may not:
 - contain roofing material, siding, paving material, flora, balloons or lights, or any other similar building, landscaping, or nonstandard decorative component;

- be attached in any way to plant material, a traffic control device, a light, a trailer, a vehicle, or any other existing structure or object;
- include the painting of architectural surfaces;
- threaten the public health or safety;
- be larger than four feet by six feet;
- violate a law;
- contain language, graphics, or any display that would be offensive to the ordinary person; or
- be accompanied by music or other sounds or by streamers or is otherwise distracting to motorists.
