Robert E. Loeffler, 74, of Sebewaing died Friday, Feb. 4, 2000, at Scheurer Hospital in Pigeon following a two-and-a-half-year illness. He was born July 16, 1925, in Sebewaing, son of the late George and Clara (Zamke) Loeffler. Bob had been employed by the Chesapeake & Ohio Railroad for 42 years before retiring in 1985. He was a member of the Immanuel Lutheran Church in Sebewaing and the American Legion Sebewaing Post No. 293. He served in the U.S.
