Registration starts <u>February 1st.</u> The Deadline to sign up is <u>Tuesday, April 15, 2025.</u>

The program begins on April 18, 2025.

What is a CSA?

CSA stands for community-supported agriculture. The purpose of CSA programs is to help support the farmer in the beginning of the year by purchasing seeds and fertilizer, making necessary repairs to equipment, and so on to help make the season happen. It is similar to buying your ski season pass in July for the coming season, whether or not it snows. In a CSA program, you as a "Member" purchase a share of Jillybeans Farmstand's harvest of the coming season before the growing season and then visit the stand when it is convenient for you as often as you wish from Good Friday (March 29, 2024) until we close on December 24th and purchase as much or as little as you need! This includes ANYTHING we sell at the stand: flowers, jam, dairy products, pies, meats, produce, strawberries and so much more.

Why are CSAs Important? What are the risks of farming?

Upon becoming a "Member" at Jillybeans we all take on the risks of farming. Not only are there risks to farming in this lovely New England area, but there are many rewards, too! Some risks we take are the unpredictability of the weather, possible natural disasters to our crops, and the chance the crops may not take and don't grow. Those are only some basic ones we, as farmers, deal with.

The benefits are much more rewarding than the risks. Upon harvesting, the crop yield depends on the season but we have multiple plantings of each crop to ensure we are able to pick the ones that flourish through the whole season and have them readily available on our stand. This is where a CSA Program is vital to farms. The early funds they receive are vital in helping purchase seeds and fertilizer, properly fix all of the equipment, and jumpstart their season with any unforeseen bills that may come about.

The COVID-19 pandemic forced us to create a safe and fun way to have a CSA program in 2021. The pilot program we called "The Bean Crew" took off and has a considerable following. We have decided this is the best way for all to continue providing a CSA program into 2023 again. This will help us, help you be able to come to the stand and get produce and groceries you may need for that time being. Or even some veggie plants to grow your own veggies! All and all, we just want our community happy, healthy, and able to obtain the freshest and most nutritious food around. <u>Life is stressful enough</u>; just come grab what you need!

What are some of our farming practices?

GMO-Free seeds are the only way to go. If a plant is meant to get a disease or not grow, then that's the way it is meant to be. We do use manure and some fertilizer when absolutely necessary. Proper hand hygiene, produce washing, stand cleaning, and COVID-19 safety practices are to be followed as guided by the health department and CDC.

April 15th, 2024 is the deadline to register.



In a CSA program, you as a "Member" purchase a share of Jillybeans Farmstand's harvest of the coming 2023 season prior to the growing season, and then visit the stand when it is convenient for you as often as you wish and purchase as much or as little as you need! This includes ANYTHING we sell at the stand. We wish for our entire community to benefit from our CSA this season and for many years to come. The KIDZ Club has been created to give kids a sense of healthy food options they can choose on their own or with the guidance of their family and to purchase it with their very own card! This gives them a sense of accomplishment, independence and willingness to try new things!

Why do we have registration dates if we are doing a card program instead of the traditional weekly box program?

The registration dates are important because they are supporting us for the coming season. Supporting us during the season is one thing when the stand is open, showing support prior to us opening is the whole purpose of the CSA which is why most farmers have strict CSA deadlines. These deadlines also give us time to get all of the paperwork in order and allow us time to order all of the yearly unique Bean Crew Club Cards and get them in time for the season to start. A lot is going on behind the scenes all of the time, especially during the Late Winter and Early Spring months ,besides getting ready for the CSA season in preparation for the greenhouse season and growing season in fields.
