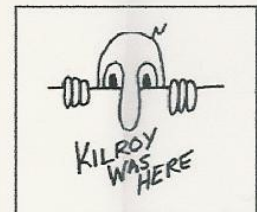
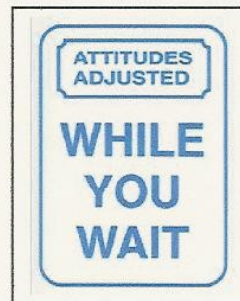
**Web Software Offers:**
