Eleventh Sunday in Ordinary Time
Mark 4:26-34

“With many such parables he spoke the word to them as they were able to understand it.”

Jesus used parables, short stories with images of things, places and the daily life of the people of his day to convey TRUTHS that they were not able to fully understand because of their lack of education and the natural limits of human ability to comprehend transcendent reality. Other than the “scribes” that Jesus often mentions along with the “chief priest and Pharisees,” most people did not read and write. There were no newspapers, books, radio, television, computers, Internet, cell phones or tablets with wifi access. People communicated face to face. They spoke to each other. They talked about their life, business, faith and the world in which they lived. They often used images, stories, and parables because they were easier to remember than a complicated academic dissertation. St. Mark records Jesus telling the parable of the mustard seed to teach about the Kingdom of God. He did not eliminate the mystery about the Kingdom, but those who heard Him learned the TRUTH that it included them. And it includes us. What a great story.

VOCARE 2018 is **Friday, September 14, 2018** at the Owensboro Convention Center. It begins with a social hour at 5 PM and dinner/program at 6 PM. The speakers will represent 70+ years of collective vocations as we have three of our own diocesan priests sharing about their love of the priesthood.

As you are aware, VOCARE is Bishop William Medley’s event to celebrate vocations to priesthood, marriage and religious life. Proceeds from this event assist in funding the formation of our seminarians and women religious. The Bishop’s Office coordinates with the Vocations Office to host this event. This year marks the 5th Annual VOCARE!

The cost for VOCARE is \$500 for a table that seats 8 people. Individual seats may be purchased for \$65 or two for \$125.
