DESCRIPTION: When Colt entered the archery market, they never made their own bows. They contracted them out (first to Wing, and later to Ben Pearson) The early Hartford CT Colts such as this one were made by Wing Archery (Bob Lee). This Plainsman has been reconditioned. Cherry riser. I saved the original specs on the riser (rather than stripping them along with the rest of the old varnish, which is why you can see the original patch of varnish around the specs. This is an attractive and comfortable bow. Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Beveled arrow shelf. Overlays and tips are in good condition. No drilled holes; No chips, dings or cracks. No crazing or stress cracks; A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. One decal is a reproduction, and the other is in poor/fair condition. This bow was put to a stress test (held at full draw for 12 hours) to make sure the old glues on the laminates still held and no stress cracks developed.
