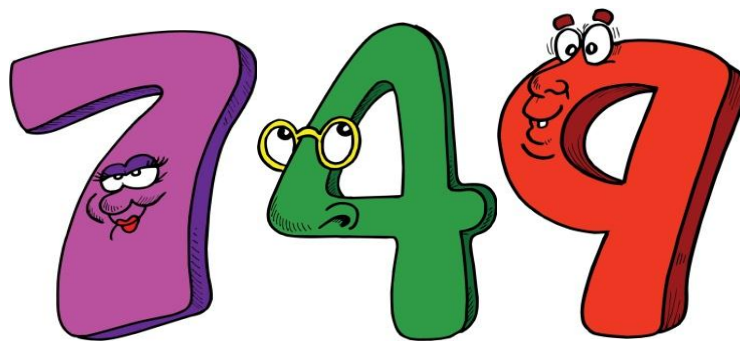

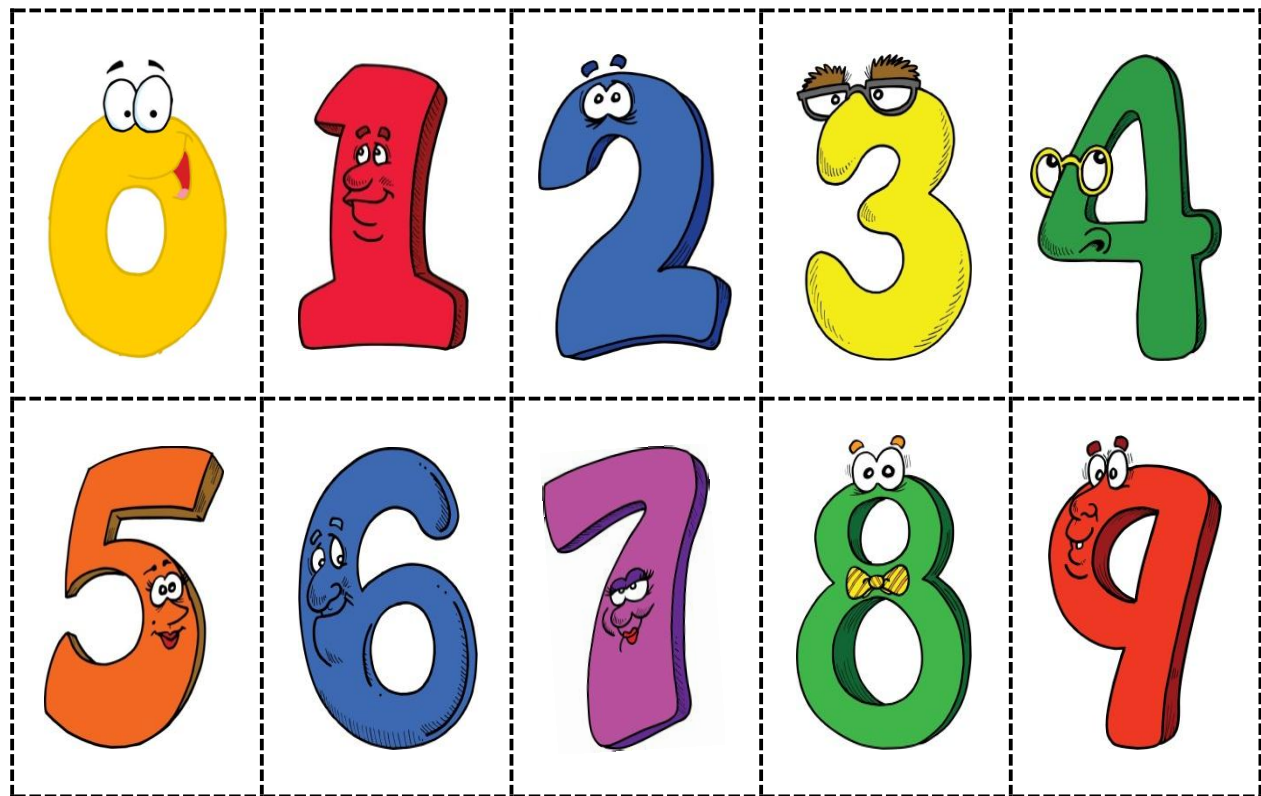
Place Value Game



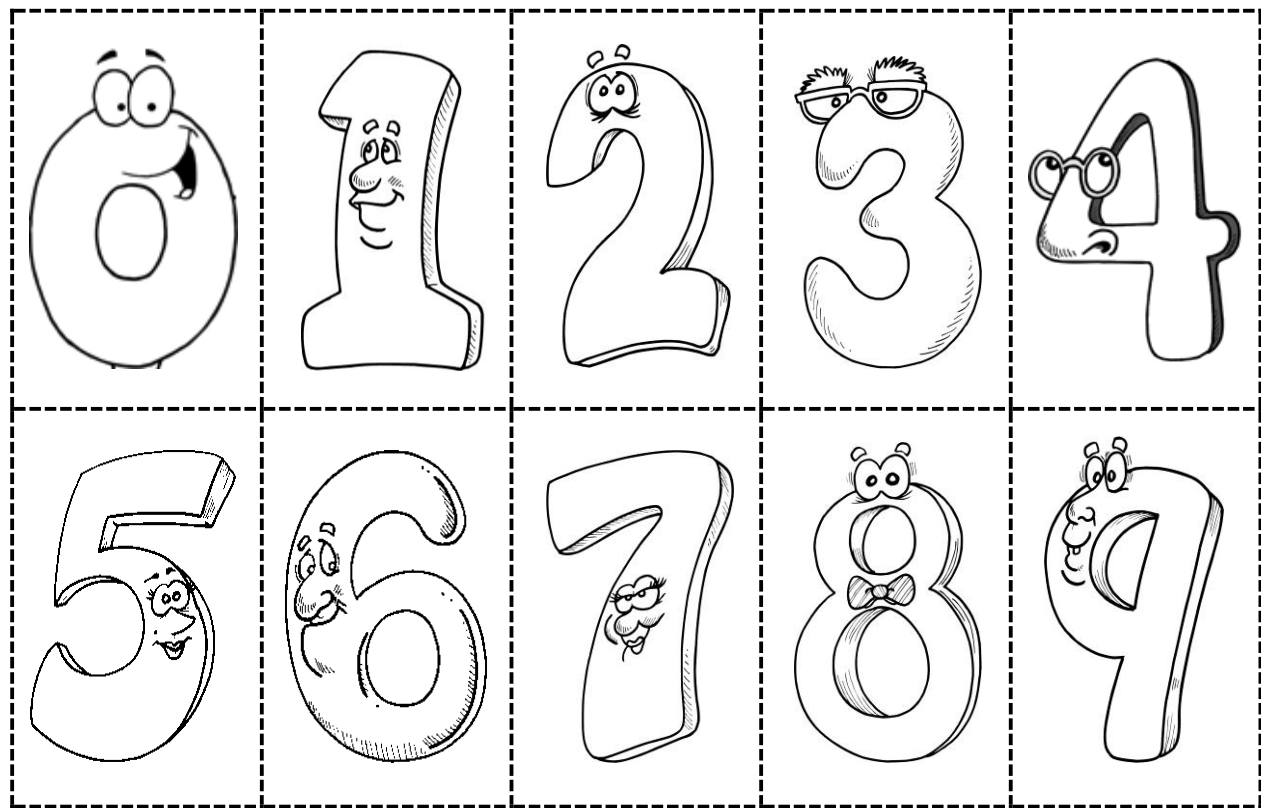
Directions:

- Print the game pages that you will use (black and white or color) on heavy paper, photo paper, or card stock.
- Give each child a set of the Numbers and a Game Board Page. (*Some students may want to color in the black and white number set.*)
- Students can play the game with either chart #1 or chart #2.
- Students cut out the numbers, shuffle them, and place the cards face down on a flat surface.
- Player one picks up the top card from his/her pile and places it on an open column on his/her game board chart. Once the number card is placed on the game board it cannot be moved.
- Player two picks up the top card on his/her pile and places it on an open column on his/her game board chart.
- Players continue to take turns until all columns on the chart are filled in.
- Each player reads his/her number. The player with the greater number wins.
- Students tally each round. The first player to win 5 rounds is the winner.
