

**\*\*\*SEEDLINGS AVAILABLE THIS YEAR\*\*\***

**All are native to Pennsylvania**

**AMERICAN CHESTNUT HYBRID**

(Castanea dentate x) A fast growing hybrid of the American Chestnut can reach heights of 80 to 100 feet. Best planted in full sun in well drained soil. Best planted in groups to ensure pollination. Should produce nuts in 10 to 12 years. 1Yr. Seedlings 10-12 inches. **3 per package, \$8.00 per package.**

**AMERICAN HORNBEAM**

Also known as "IRONWOOD TREE or BLUE BEECH". Small understory tree found in deep moist soil and on dry rock ridges. Good ornamental and wildlife tree, provides both food and cover. Grows in clusters. 1-Yr. Seedlings 3-6 inches. **6 per package, \$8.00 per package**

**SWEET CRABAPPLE**

A native deciduous tree with short trunk and a wide spreading head of branches. Grows 20 to 30 feet with a spread of 15 to 25 feet. Adaptable to varying soil conditions. Suited for landscape or wildlife plantings. 1Yr. Seedlings 2-4 inches. **6 per package, \$8.00 per package.**

**SHADBLOW SERVICEBERRY**

Also known as Juneberry. One of the 1<sup>st</sup> native trees to bloom in the spring with billowy masses of small white flowers. Berrylike edible fruit in mid-summer is very attractive to birds. Grows 25 to 30 feet. 1Yr. Seedlings 4-8 inches **6 per package, \$8.00 per package**

**PERSIMMON**

A native tree 25 to 40 foot tall, 20 to 35 foot width at maturity. Slender with an oval crown, often very symmetrical. Fragrant white flowers with an orange edible fruit after a hard frost. Need several trees to pollinate so plant all in the same area. 1-Yr. Seedlings 4-8 inches. **6 per package, \$8.00 per package**

**WINTERBERRY HOLLY**

Height and spread 6 to 12 feet. One of the best deciduous plants for fall and winter color. Native to northeastern U.S. Female plants produce bright red berries in early fall while leaves are still green and remain until mid winter after leaves drop. All 6 should be planted in same area to ensure pollination and berries. 2-Yr. Seedlings 12-18 inches. **6 per package, \$8.00 per package** (This is not the evergreen variety)

**WASHINGTON HAWRHORN**

Grows to a height of 25 to 30 feet and spreads 20 to 25 feet. Clusters of small single white flowers in May and early June developing to bright red fruit in fall & early winter. Loved by birds and wildlife. It has thorns. 1Yr. Seedlings 3-6 inches **6 per package, \$8.00 per package**

**WHITE OAK**

Native tree that grows well in deep loamy well drained soil. Growing 60 to 80 feet. Leaves hang on long into fall and early winter. Most prolific lumber tree in North America. All wildlife relishes it acorns. 2Yr. Seedlings 12-18 inches. **6 per package, \$8.00 per package.**

**EASTERN WHITE PINE**

Fast growing to 100 feet. A fine needled pine with soft light green/blue 4 inch needles. Grows in a wide range of conditions from dry and rocky to wet and swampy. Excellent ornamental and forms a dense screen. 2Yr. Seedlings 5-10 inches. **8 seedling per package, \$8.00 per package.**

**AMERICAN RED PINE**

Rapid growing pyramidal pine with flexible, sharply pointed dark green needles. Very hardy, grows well in a variety of soils. Good as an ornamental or a wind break. 2Yr. Seedlings 3-5 inches. **8 per package, \$8.00 per package.**

**\*\*\*FRUIT TREES (ALL SEMI-DWARF)\*\*\***

**APPLE – ROYAL COURT**

Royal Court is an improved strain of Cortland coloring to a solid blush. This selection has now been fruited by many growers in the Northeast, and is considered superior to all other Cortland strains. Matures mid-Sept. 3/8 to 5/8 inches in diameter, 4-6 feet tall. **1/\$12.00**

**APPLE – HONEY CRISP**

Mid-season apple with a light orange/red color over yellow. Crisp juicy sweet apple that stores well. Very winter hardy. Matures mid-September. ½ to 5/8 inches in diameter on G-210 rootstock, 4-6 feet tall. **1/\$12.00**

**APPLE – ENTERPRISE**

Late season apple with a deep red color and remarkable keeping qualities. Very disease resistant to fireblight and apple rust and moderately resistant to powdery mildew. An excellent wildlife planting because it requires very little maintenance and matures mid October. 3/8 inches in diameter on EMLA 7 rootstock, 4-6 feet tall. **1/\$12.00**

**APPLE – GOLDEN DELICIOUS**

(Gibson Cltv) One of the most widely planted apple cultivars worldwide. Fruit is firm medium to large with the classic Golden Delicious flavor. Tree is spreading, productive and easy to manage. Matures last week of September. Good choice for the home gardener. 1/2 to 5/8 inches in diameter on EMLA 7 rootstock, 4-6 feet tall. **1/\$12.00**

**APPLE – CrimsonCrisp**

New late season disease resistant variety. Fruit is medium sized with a very attractive crimson red color. Very firm, crisp texture with a tart complex flavor. Tree is very grower friendly with a spreading habit, fruiting throughout tree on two and three year old branches Matures mid October. ½ to 5/8 inches in diameter on G-890 rootstock, 4-6 feet tall. **1/\$15.00**

**CHERRY – MONTMORENCY**

A tart cherry that is still very sweet. Fruit is bright red, juicy and medium sized. Winter Hardy. Fruit ready in early July. 3/8 inches in diameter, 4-5 feet tall. **1/\$12.00**

**PEAR – HARROW SWEET**

A late-season pear developed by the Harrow Research Station in Ontario, Canada, AC™ Harrow Sweet ripens approximately mid September This variety has shown very good resistance to fire blight. The fruit size and appearance are similar to that of Bartlett. Trees should be thinned to maintain fruit size and avoid biennial bearing. 1/2 to 5/8 inches in diameter, 4-6 feet tall. **1/\$12.00**

**PEACH – LORING**

Large, firm yellow fleshed freestone peach. Tree is vigorous, and productive. Excellent for freezing and canning. Ripens 1<sup>st</sup> of August. ½ to 5/8 inches in diameter, 3-5 feet tall. **1/\$12.00**

**PLUM – METHLEY**

Early plum with sweet red flesh, very juicy and a distinct flavor. Ripen mid July and is self-fruitful. 3/8 to 5/8 inches in diameter, 4-6 feet tall. **1/\$12.00**

**EASTERN BLUEBIRD NESTING BOX**

Constructed from kiln dried inland red cedar. Features: 7/8 inch predator guard, overhanging roof with ventilation, back cover to stop rain seepage, bottom slots for drainage, easy open front for monitoring and cleaning, exit. Place in open area with scattered trees. Size: 7.25" X 9.25inches X 12; hole size: 1.5 inches.
