As our church year begins to wind down, the lectionary texts for October remind us of Jesus' way of teaching in parables. The first Sunday in October brings us the parable of the Wicked Tenants. As the religious leaders plot Jesus' death, they do not realize that ironically they will bring about the fulfillment of Scriptures. The second week we read the parable of the Wedding Banquet where Jesus reminds us that the blessings of God's kingdom are available to all people. Week three sees the Pharisees trying to trap Jesus by asking questions about paying taxes. And the last week of the month we will celebrate Reformation Sunday with readings from Jeremiah 31, Psalm 46, Romans 3 and the Gospel of John.

This celebration of the Reformation that was lead by Martin Luther is one of my favorite Sundays in the church year. Not only do I get to wear my beautiful red stole given to me at my ordination by my children, but we get to celebrate who we are as Christians. We celebrate the good news of God's ever-faithful grace. We are reminded that we are set free each day to do God's work in the world; to love God and love our neighbor as ourselves.




As we maneuver our way through these uncertain times, we can be grateful God does not change and that He walks beside us every (sometimes unsteady) step of the way.
