


REFLECTIONS ON THE READINGS

OF DEATH AND NEW LIFE

Fr. Bill's topic on the first night of the Mission was on new hope and new life. All the readings this Sunday touch on the same theme. Israel's exile into Babylon was like death, and their return to their homeland was like a new life, a spiritual renewal (Ezekiel 37:12-14). In his letter to the Romans, Paul speaks of the Spirit Who raised Jesus from the dead and that that same Spirit is at work in each of us (Rom 8:8-11).



The Gospel (John 11:1-45) gives us a more visual image of a new life in the raising of Lazarus from the dead. Jesus shows us that He's the Lord of life and death. Lent is about dying to our sins and ourselves so that we can rise to a new (renewed) life at Easter. In these remaining days of Lent, may we intensify our efforts to die to our old selves, or mainly focus on what we've been doing so far. May azarus from the Dead we truly experience renewal at Easter. Amen.



OUR 2014 LENTEN & EASTER WISH LIST




