DESCRIPTION: Here is an iconic BP Pinto in an ideal 40# draw weight. The BP Pinto has always been a strikingly beautiful bow, but it also performs well. At 40#, this is suitable for hunting as well as the archery range. Made from a combination of black holly, white holly, and cherry, this is a great looking recurve. Very comfortable pistol grip. Has the original finish that was cleaned up and touched up with a couple of coats of Tru-Oil. This bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Overlays and tips are in great condition. No drilled holes. No chips, dings or cracks. No stress lines or crazing. There was one long scratch and one smaller one near the Logo on the limb that was filled (see pic on the last page). This was a scratch in the finish/limb glass, and not a stress line. A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. Decal is in very good shape. Overall, this is a really nice bow in excellent condition for its age. This bow sold for \$70 in 66, which translates to \$539 in 2020 inflation adjusted dollars.

Note: The limbs are white, but one appears blueish in the picture. It is a camera thing.
