

## Catechist: A Witness of Faith

The catechist is *a witness of faith and keeper of the memory of God*. "In experiencing the goodness and truth of the Gospel in his/her encounter with the person of Jesus, the catechist keeps, nourishes, and bears witness to the new life that stems from this, and becomes a sign for others."

(Directory for Catechesis p. 73)

In this aspect all Christians are called to be catechists, for we are all called to be witnesses of faith by the very lives we lead. Bishops, priests, deacons, consecrated persons, and lay people (including parents, godparents, grandparents, etc) are all catechists in some dimension.

*Living out your daily lives is a call to be a catechist – a witness of faith. How are you doing this in your own life? Can people recognize you as a follower of Christ in your daily actions?*


