We will also have banners at the front of the neighborhood. **DO NOT STAPLE/TAPE** signs to stop sign posts, lamp posts, or street sign posts.

Ads will be placed in the newspaper as well as online to promote the neighborhood sale and special staging in the pool parking lot.

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DUMPSTER:

A dumpster will be available starting Thursday, April 21 through Tuesday April 26, in the pool parking lot. This will be for homeowner's use only. **DO NOT** use the contractor's dumpster at the pool parking lot circle. This is for the construction of the clubhouse only. The neighborhood dumpster will be placed at the entrance to the pool parking lot, on the right.

DO NOT put any electronic equipment (Appliances, computers, radios), tires, paint, chemicals, household cleaners, pesticides, batteries, asphalt, bricks, mortar, engine oil, etc. Remember the parking lot is under video surveillance.

A recycling drop-off site is located at the Public Works Facility on Woodside Park
Drive in <u>Simpsonville</u>. It is open Monday through Friday, 7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. The
Public Works site accepts electronics from households (televisions, computers,
computer monitors, printers and other electronic equipment) and used motor oil, filters and bottles.

MAULDIN SIGN ORDINANCE #758

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE MAULDIN ZONING ORDINANCE ARTICLE 6, SIGN ORDINACE IN ORDER TO ENHANCE THE APPEARANCE OF THE CITY OF MAULDIN AND TO CLARIFY THE ORDINANCE:

Temporary Yard Sale and Garage Sale Signs. Provided such signs comply with the following standards:

- The number of such signs shall be limited to three (3) signs total, only two (2) of which may be located off-premises and with the property owner's consent for which the sign is placed. All signs shall bear the address and/or location for which the sale is being advertised.
- 2. Signs shall be located on private property and shall be setback a minimum of five (5) feet from the street right-of-way line. In no circumstance shall said sign encroach into the street right-of-way; nor shall such sign obstruct visibility at street intersections or main entrances into a subdivision or other form of housing or commercial developments;
- 3. Signs shall not exceed three (3) feet in height and four (4) square feet in sign face area (size).
- 4. Such signs shall not be erected more than one (1) day before the event and shall be removed not later than 8:00am the day following the sale date.
