

On July 15, 2014 the Village Board voted to raise the water rates. The Village is trying to secure a matching funds grant from USDA/RD for the replacement of the water mains in the business district. The business district is located on Maple Avenue in front of Carey's grocery and the Library. These water mains are the oldest in the Village and replacing them will help address the problem of intermittent rusty water in the Village.
