



CODE OF CONDUCT

It is our goal to provide a Christian atmosphere, where students will feel they are in a safe place for them to have fun, dance and to glorify God.

Participation at our dance is an opportunity which encourages Christian behavior at all times. Students need to carry themselves with an attitude that represents Christ. Each student is expected to show respect for the staff and parents at all times.

God has made it clear throughout Scripture that His standards are high. *"Whatsoever you do, do it from the heart, as to the Lord, and not to men."* ~Colossians 3:23. Priorities must be in order: God, Family, School, Extra-curricular activities, etc. *"Seek ye therefore first the kingdom of God, and his justice, and all these things shall be added unto you."* ~Matthew 6:33.

Therefore, we ask that **BOTH STUDENT AND PARENT** read and sign the following agreement.

1. No name-calling or profanity is allowed.
2. Unnecessary touching or misuse of property is prohibited. Any damage done to property by the student will be replaced or repaired by the student and parent.
3. Students are expected to dress appropriately and modestly. (for girls: dresses should be to the knee or floor length, not low cut in front or back, no strapless dresses, no bare midriff; for boys: suit and tie, no jeans, no t-shirts)
4. No visible tattoos.
5. Inappropriate displays of affection are not allowed and may be cause for immediate removal from the dance.
6. Drugs, alcohol, smoking, and weapons are STRICTLY prohibited for all students and parents on premises. Possession of any of these items will result in immediate removal from the dance.
7. Students must stay in designated areas, under adult supervision. If outside of a designated area and/or if there is not an adult present, students are in violation of this rule. Proceed immediately to a designated area where an adult is present.
8. Assisting and encouraging positive behavior among fellow students is a positive thing. Setting a good example is the primary way that we can affect other's behavior.
9. The planning committee encourages parents and students to pray for each other and all those involved in the planning and execution of the dance, keeping in mind that God uses all circumstances for the good of those who love Him.~ Romans 8:28.
10. Other rules may be established by the dance committee during the course of the dance, depending on circumstances.

I have read and discussed the behavior guidelines and understand what is required of me and my student as far as behavior, and agree to abide by these rules in a respectful manner. I understand that recurring violations of this agreement may result in my or my student's removal from the dance with NO REFUND.
