

We are happy that we can offer your household food once every seven days. In order to serve you best, we require some assistance. Please note that you must provide the information we need for each visit to the Food Bank. Although additional information may be requested as needed, the following is a list documentation required to complete Food Bank interviews:

- Current ID
- Dates of Birth and Social Security Number for each member of the household
- Proof of Saline County Residence (a recent piece of mail with your name and current address)
- Proof of all household income for the preceding 30 days (paycheck stubs, unemployment verification, child support verification, worker's compensation)
- Award letter from Social Security (SSI, SSDI).
- Award letter from DCF (SNAP-food stamp assistance, TANF-cash assistance)
- > Student Financial Aid
- Paid out receipts for items such as the following (Rent, Westar Energy, Water, Kansas Gas, Fuel for Vehicle, Clothing, Child Care, Medical Expenses, Medication, Telephone, Cable, Internet, and Food.)
- Federal & State Income Tax Refund Information
