

2024 Ashton Woods Pool Rules and Information

All members are responsible for knowing these rules and discussing them with their household, children and guests. These rules are designed for the safety of all members and the protection of your privileges. Please remember that the rights, privileges and safety of all members, board members and lifeguards should be respected at ALL TIMES.

Failure to follow these rules will be grounds for the suspension of privileges or loss of membership.

- 1. Ashton Woods' Pool Director, Board of Directors and Lifeguards have the authority to enforce all rules and regulations including:
 - Suspending member privileges for any violation of these rules.
 - Restricting the use of any audio devices if the volume is too loud.
 - Closing the facility for safety, sanitation or weather related issues.
 - Dispose of any articles left at the facility
 - Notify law enforcement if necessary.
- 2. Children under the age of 14 years old MUST be under the direct supervision of an adult member at all times. Unsupervised children older than 14 years old MUST pass a swim test conducted by the lifeguards. Children are NOT allowed to bring in guests on their own.
- 3. All members and their guests MUST show their code and sign in at the lifeguard desk daily. It is NOT the responsibility of the lifeguard to remember whether our members have previously entered in the past. Member verification checks may be done periodically throughout the day by lifeguards, Pool Director and Board Members.

- 4. **Guest passes are \$5 per day, per guest.** A family is allowed up to 5 guests per visit. You may pay with cash upon entering. If the Snack Shack is open, you may pay with credit or debit card. Your guests MUST REMAIN UNDER MEMBER ADULT SUPERVISION AT ALL TIMES. You are responsible for your guests.
- 5. Outside Members MUST abide by the same pool rules that apply to our residents. Non-Resident membership is not guaranteed and does not renew yearly. Applications must reapply every year they wish to join. The Board of Directors reserve the right to deny and revoke all membership privileges for non-compliance with pool rules. Non resident members are NOT entitled to guest passes.
- 6. The Lifeguards are in charge. Whatever they say goes Please show them the respect they deserve while keeping you and your children and guests safe.

FOR SAFETY REASONS:

- A lifeguard must be on duty at all times whenever the pool is occupied.
- The pool will be closed on cloudy days when the outside temperature is 69 degrees or below.
- Members will be asked to leave the pool facility when weather requires that the pool be closed either temporarily or for the day.
- All hair longer than shoulder length should be secured with a hair tie.
- Glass is NOT permitted inside the pool gates, this includes baby bottles.
- NO face masks or snorkel type masks allowed. Goggles are permitted.
- Only United States Coast Guard approved life preservers are allowed.
- Bikes, roller skates, roller blades, skateboards or the like are NOT allowed inside the pool gates.
- Eyeglasses need while in the pool should be secured with a strap.

- Small children and weaker swimmers are restricted to pool depths not exceeding their shoulder level (determined by a lifeguard)
- Running, dunking, pushing, shoulder riding, chicken-fighting or other horse play is NOT permitted.
- Only ONE PERSON at a time is permitted on the diving board.
- Children must have passed a swim test to use the diving board. Swimmers must dive or jump straight out from the board. NO jumping or diving towards either side of the pool.
- Back flips are NOT permitted from the diving board or pool deck at any time.
- No hanging from the diving board, lifeguard stands or lap ropes.
- Alcohol is not permitted on the property. Our Lifeguards and Board of Directors have the right to turn away any member or guest believed to be intoxicated.
- No running or jumping inside the Kiddie Pool gates.
- The Kiddie Pool is for children age 5 or under (unless otherwise given special permission) and children MUST BE SUPERVISED BY THEIR ADULT AT ALL TIMES. There is no lifeguard assigned to the kiddie pool area.
- Children cannot be left unattended for ANY TIME for ANY REASON.
- Chemical Safety Checks will be called at 45 minutes past each hour to allow for safely checking chemical levels. NO EXCEPTIONS. Only adults 18 or older are allowed in the pool during this time. All others must go back to their chairs until Safety Check is over.

FOR COURTESY REASONS

- The use of profanity and lewd behavior is NOT permitted. This is a family friendly pool and we proudly operate it as such.
- Smoking or Vaping inside the pool gates or poorhouse is NOT permitted. You must smoke at least 20 feet outside the pool gates, no exceptions. If a child is with you, they cannot be left unattended.
- When leaving for the day, please throw away all trash and put chair back to their rightful place. Please return all used floats, life preservers and toys to their locations.
- Water and squirt guns are NOT PERMITTED. No exceptions.
- Food and drink are not allowed inside the pool or while sitting on the sides of the pool.
- Bathing Suits MUST be worn at all times. Cut-offs and undergarments are not permitted.
- Spitting in the pool area is grounds for dismissal for the day.
- Gum is NOT allowed inside the pool gates.
- Pets are not allowed inside the pool gates unless required for disability purposes.
- Inappropriate behavior by adults and children alike will NOT BE TOLERATED and are grounds for dismissal. Please report any issues you see to the Lifeguard on Duty, Pool Director or Board Members.
- No entering the pool gates prior to opening time except by Ashton Woods Pool Staff or Board Members.

POOL VIOLATIONS WILL BE ADDRESSED AS FOLLOWS

- First offense will receive a verbal warning.
- Second offense will be asked to sit out for a specified period of time as determined by the Lifeguard(s), Pool Director or Board of Directors.
- Third offense will result in removal for the remainder of the day.
- Continued violations will result in removal for longer than one day, as determined by the Pool Director and Board of Directors.
- Suspension from the Pool includes the ENTIRE common area, beginning at the parking to gate. Refusal to leave this area may result in criminal charges.
