  - L. Communications Director's Report (Vicki Reinemann) – Vicki was not able to attend today's meeting and probably can't attend the concert as well. Here is what she requested we discuss tonight:
    - \*We need to finalize what we are selling at the concert and need people to head up each of the tables. We should use our pot luck sign holders to hold signs with the prices of the raffle tickets, cookies exchange pricing, and band logo pricing. They are in the plastic file drawers in the band library.
