Grace...Heaven is a free gift

“The wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.” (Romans 6:23) We cannot earn our way to heaven and none of us really deserve to go. It is a gift.

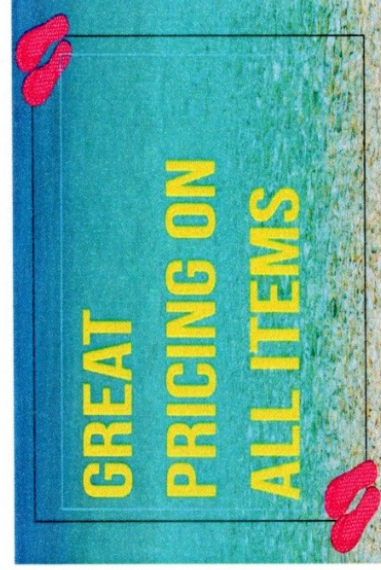
