A RESOLUTION

To authorize, direct and empower the Mayor, on behalf of the City of Fostoria, Ohio to enter into a Joint Cooperating Agreement between Seneca County, the City of Tiffin and the City of Fostoria for the fiscal year 2020 Community Housing Impact & Preservation (CHIP) program for the purpose of addressing local housing needs, and declaring an emergency to exist.

WHEREAS, the Housing Advisory Committee identified housing needs in the City of Fostoria, Ohio and elsewhere; and,

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio, Development Services Agency, Office of Community Development (OCD), provides financial assistance to local governments under its Fiscal Year 2020 Community Housing Impact & Preservation (CHIP) program for the purpose of addressing local housing needs; and,

WHEREAS, OCD now encourages local CHIP eligible grantees to request funds as partners in one application; and,

WHEREAS, each of the partners desires to file a combined application under the CHIP Program to receive financial assistance to address the needs identified in their individual CHIP.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Fostoria, Seneca, Hancock, and Wood Counties, Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor, on behalf of the City, is authorized, directed and empowered to enter into a Joint Cooperating Agreement between Seneca County, the City of Tiffin and the City of Fostoria, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein as though fully re-written herein, for the fiscal year 2020 Community Housing Impact & Preservation (CHIP) program for the purpose of addressing local housing needs.

SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, and in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, welfare and safety, and for the

further reason that the City must meet certain deadlines for submission of the application to the State of Ohio Development Services Agency, Office of Community Development.

THEREFORE, upon the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, and signature by the Mayor, this resolution shall go into immediate force and effect.
