All vendors/exhibitors will receive two (2) passes for the weekend. Every worker MUST have a pass. Additional passes are \$5 per day.

Set-up:

- Check in and register as you arrive. Look for the "Vendor Registration" signs.
- Begins at 8:00 AM on Friday. I will send out detailed instructions with set-up instructions and times just prior to the rodeo via email.
- You must be completely set up by 12:00 pm, Noon on Friday. If you are a food vendor you will need to be inspected by the Jarrell Fire Marshall.

Breakdown:

- Vehicle access inside the Sheriff's Posse Arena is not permitted until 10:30 pm on Saturday.
- Booth items may be removed Friday night. No overnight security is provided by the Posse.

Vehicles:

- Vendors will be able to park in the designated vendor parking area.
- Parking directions will be provided at check in.

Event Hours:

- Friday Booths open from 6:00 pm to 10 pm minimum.
- Saturday Booths open from 6:00 pm to 10 pm minimum.

Sales Information:

- All vendors must complete the detailed description of ALL merchandise to be sold including pricing.
- Any merchandise not listed must be approved by the WCSP Sergeant before allowed to be sold during the Sheriff's Posse Rodeo.
- The WCSP will not allow the sale of merchandise at the event that depicts illegal weapons, illegal drug use or paraphernalia, or objectionable language. The WCSP Sergeant has the final authority over any concerns with merchandise.
- Responsibility for reporting and paying all fees and taxes to federal, state and local entities are solely on the exhibitor/vendor. The tax rate in Jarrell is 8.25%
- The WCSP Rodeo reserves the right to refuse any vendors/exhibitors.
- Williamson County Sheriff's Posse will be the only source of alcohol sales. No vendors can sell alcohol.
- No second-hand items can be sold.
- Food vendors have the responsibility of obtaining their food permit by contacting: http://www.wcchd.org/services/food_and_restaurant/ Be sure to do this with plenty of advance notice so that you can get your permit in time.
- We will be offering to our food vendors the opportunity to provide their products on Thursday for the participants and onlookers for Slack. That should begin around 7:00 pm. Please contact the Posse Sergeant directly to participate in Thursday night food vending.
- Application Deadline: Your application is due by the end of the business day no later than May 1
 and must be sent to the Posse Sergeant. After May 1, Applications will only be accepted if there
 is space left to be filled. Food vendors fill up fast, so get your application in early.
- No food or craft vendors will be permitted to spend the night inside the fenced-in area of the Sheriff's Posse Arena.

- Booth spaces will be assigned at check in. We only provide electricity and space. You bring your own tables, chairs, lights, displays etc.
- Booth fee is non-refundable *unless* booth space is denied.
- No early breakdown or late set up will be allowed. Please notify the Sergeant in case of emergency.
- Booth spaces do not have direct lighting overhead. Please provide your own light fixtures. Electricity is available.
- The WCSP Sergeant will establish a set-up schedule and determine a breakdown plan prior to the rodeo. This will ease congestion within the vendor area and contribute to personal safety.
