ATTENTION:

All students & parents are required to read this information thoroughly and be prepared to comply with important health protocols. I can't stress the importance of this enough. Marching Band is a class. It MUST BE on your schedule. Contact your counselor immediately if it isn't. All students must be enrolled in this year's Google Classroom (Code: jop76zc), and all students and parents must be signed up to this year's Remind list. (Instructions have been sent to the old lists.) Please make these important communication tools an immediate priority.

Our band doesn't have "part-time" members. ALL rehearsals and ALL performances are required, period! Marching Band commitments come before employment and extra-curricular or club activities. (All reasonable efforts will be made to work out conflicts with other school activities.)

Marching Band Participation Fee

The current situation is preventing us from doing things as we usually do. As a result the camp fee has been significantly reduced this year. The fee is \$50.00 Due the first day of Band Camp, August 24th (includes end of the year dry cleaning).

Performance Requirements

Pregame and MSBOA show music *must be memorized!* You'll be submitting recordings to our Google Classroom. Students will be permitted to use lyres for other music as needed.

Personal Bag for Camp

All necessary equipment needs to be obtained and kept in a backpack or duffle. The bag should contain everything needed including but not limited to: Refillable water bottle(s) CLEARLY MARKED with your name, sunscreen, healthy snacks, a hat, and any other personal needs. Also included should be extra reeds, lubricants, swabs, and anything else you need to keep your instrument in top playing condition.

STUDENTS ARE POSITIVELY NOT PERMITTED TO SHARE PERSONAL ITEMS - WITHOUT EXCEPTION.

Pre-Season Camp Information

Where: Royal Oak High School Practice Field

Who: All Marching Band Membership (Winds/Battery/Front Ensemble/Color Guard)

When: August 20th for freshmen, new members and ALL BLUE SHIRTS / August 24-28th for all. Uniform: During camp, students wear a uniform T-Shirt at all rehearsals. (Distributed at 1st rehearsal.) Additional shirts may be purchased for \$10 each. Having an extra shirt or two is recommended.

Students are expected to attend all rehearsals during pre-season camp. Conflicts with employers or other non-school

organizations must be avoided. Contact Mr. Jensen NOW if you have a conflict with any of the rehearsals.

8:00 - 11:00am Field Rehearsal

Only when pre-rehearsal procedures are complete, stand in place at your designated spot on the field for attendance. No Instruments, *they are to be left at home.* Masks must be worn properly at all times without exception. Once students are accounted for and requirements are met, rehearsal begins.

11:00 – 1:00pm Home for Lunch / Rest (Students may not remain at school during this time.)

1:00 - 5:00pm Sectionals A&B

Students are only permitted to be at school during their scheduled sectional time.

Students with no assigned afternoon sectional will have a video submission assignment, due that day.

Video Submissions will be graded and contribute to the final grade in the class.
