Meeting Minutes - September 22, 2022

Call to Order

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Clark at 7:02pm.

Roll Call of Board Members

Action on Minutes of Previous Meeting(s)

A Motion to approve the August 25, 2022 regular meeting minutes was made by JSB and seconded by KDN. All members were in favor.

Public Comment / Presentation

1. Dr. Gordon Eck – to discuss the commercial parcel held by Bentley within the Culbertson Realty development/now Judd Builders and the Authority's proposed plan for connection to the sewer. Dr. Eck had an issue arise and was not able to make the meeting.

Reports:

- 1. Operator
 - a. Monthly Report. Noted and reviewed. Brief discussion on current spare parts and recommendations for other parts to have on hand. Inspection of remaining air release valves should be completed by next meeting. If all are the same size, consider purchasing a spare.

2. Engineer

- a. Monthly Report general operations. Noted and reviewed. Brief discussion on recent televising project showing sewer line in good operating order. Administrator to prepare letter to Township regarding the sinking in Reeceville Road just north of our FVPS and ask that they keep requesting PennDOT to fix. Update provided on control system project.
 - i. Consider PSI Change Order Request #1.2 for Culbertson Run motor and valve replacement. Continued discussion on logistics of replacing motor and valve at CRPS; comparison of Change Order #1 and this more recent Change Order #1.2. A Motion approving PSI's Change Order #1, dated 6/15/2022, in the amount of \$2,850.00 was made by JSB and seconded by KDN. All members were in favor.

3. Committees

- a. Finance March / June / September / December. Finance Committee met on 9/19/2022 to begin preparation of 2023 budget.
- b. Operations April / July / October / January. Operations Committee met on 9/21/2022 to conduct station visits and compile a comprehensive list of spare parts. To meeting again in 6 months.
- c. Planning May / August / November / February.

4. Administrator

- a. Monthly Report. Noted and reviewed.
 - i. Manhole Protection Rings consider purchase. Brief discussion on request of Township's Public Works Foreman to split the cost of manhole protection rings for about 12 manholes where the lid/riser are higher than the roadway and get caught by the snowplows. A Motion to split the cost of protective rings, not to exceed \$2,000, was made by KDN and seconded by JSB. All members were in favor.

New Business:

1. Grant Opportunities. New H20 PA and PA Small Water and Sewer grant programs opening up October 1, 2022 and ending December 21, 2022. Engineer briefly summarized grant requirements and provided one proposed project. To be discussed again at October meeting; engineer to gather more information concerning federal requirements.
