 - 1. Director Sauer moves to approve Director Eggleston's absence; Director Bailey seconds the

3. INTRODUCTION OF GUESTS / STAFF

a. Jenni Milsap was present in person. Krista Hymas, Jenni Brookins, and Jennifer Redding phoned in.

4. COMMENTS FROM ASSOCIATION MEMBERS AND/OR PUBLIC

- a. Jennifer Redding Fair Date Change
 - 1. If we change the date to mid-July we will be taking the risk of not having lambs, and goats make weight or possibly unfinished product. I am not in favor of the date change.
- b. Krista Hymas Weight Issues / Product Issues
 - 1. There is not a whole lot we can do for lambs and goats.
- c. Jenni Brookins A lot of animals were already bred for an August Fair Date.
 - 1. There are supplements that can be added to help with weight issues.
 - 2. We will be in competition with other Fairs when it comes to purchasing them. There is already a long list of kids wanting animals.
 - A. Its going to be another hard year.
- d. CEO Bayley Morgan Rourke said pigs and steers will not be affected as much.
- e. Jenni Milsap You can't push beef / pigs should be fine. Pushing the animals causes a lot of stress and most animals will die in the truck.
- f. Jennifer Redding Sheep can't be pushed so hard. Everyone will be pushed severely and they can't just go lay down and relax like a pig can.
- g. Jenni Milsap Kids already purchased steers. Topline steer can't be pushed.
- h. Jenni Brookins Belinda says beef can be pushed to a certain point.
 - 1. It's either a carnival or never again type of situation right now.
- i. Jenni Milsap We are losing the whole point of Fair FFA kids are breeding their own animals to take to Fair. This messes things up for them.
- j. Director Rourke I understand everyone is not in favor of changing the Fair. What do you want to happen?
- k. Director Brinkley It was a unanimous decision at the JLC meeting.
- I. Jenni Brookins It was not unanimous; I did not vote.
- m. CEO Bayley What if we move the auction outside of Fair?
- n. Director Case We've had record high sales the past 2 years. I say to move the Date up 2 weeks and we'll have a year to adapt.
- o. Director Brinkley the Auction and Fair need to happen at the same time. The kids can try different animals this year.
- Jenni Brookins We're going to have to work together to find animals for the kids. We are only 7 months away from Fair.
- q. Director Rourke Could we get them to drop weight to accommodate?
- r. Jenni Brookins Yes, but we want a finished animal.
- s. Jenni Milsap We have the highest weight limits in Northern California. A finished Goat is anywhere between 70-90 lbs.
- t. Jennifer Redding Lambs will not make weight. Maybe drop weight down to 100 vs 110; 90 lb Lamb is not a lot of meat.
- u. Jenni Milsap If we do feeder classes, we need to make sure the Buyers know ahead of time.
- v. Director Rourke Minimum weights are an option.
