FOOTNOTE ON SUPERGLUE FUMING TANKS

Everyone knows that you can take an empty fish tank, put an all-weather strip lining around the top edge, get a piece of plastic or flat even top for a lid and use a coffee cup electric warmer to heat/accelerate the fuming, small containers to hold about quarter sized amount of superglue, pyrex or stainless steel l cup container for holding hot water, and make-shift hooks, hangers from old coat hangers, etc. as an inexpensive, effective, efficient fuming chamber. After placing items on hangers, racks, etc., place hot water into chamber, place superglue onto burner (in it's container) and heat for 15 min. and let fume for 20 min., check by looking through the glass walls. Remember to have one of those razor blade (single blade) scrappers to get the old stuff off the walls as build-up does occur. Wait another 20-30 minutes, and carefully remove fumed items for dusting. Or, you can use HARDCASE packets, though \$\$\$.
