CRITERIA:

- The candidate must be an eighth (8th) grade student in a PTA school.
- Qualifications we are seeking include: Friendliness, Integrity, Enthusiasm and Commitment to task ("The All-Around Good Kid").
- Each unit may submit **only one** application for a boy **or** girl.

THE FOLLOWING MUST BE SUBMITTED WITH EACH APPLICATION:

1. Letters of recommendation from two teachers (past or present).
2. An original statement from the student of at least 50 words entitled "A Change I Would Like to See..."
3. The application which appears on the next page.

All parts must be completed to be eligible. In keeping with the policy of Western Region PTA, the award may or may not be granted at the discretion of the committee, if in the opinion of the committee, there is no candidate meeting the criteria for the award.
