Let me take this opportunity to thank everyone for their support in my latest endeavor. The support and assistance has been overwhelming. Many have asked me about the future of the WGTA Executive Officer positions, if I am successful in November.

The WGTA is bound by its Constitution and Bylaws which provide guidance regarding a transition of powers. Article III.B.1 clearly states that the Elected Vice President in the event that the President is unable to serve. The Elected Vice President is Mike Perkins, a fifth grade teacher at Stonehedge. Mike has experience in negotiations, grievances, and is knowledgeable regarding APPR

and state education law. Mike would become the president on January 1, 2019 and would serve out the remainder of the term until June, 2019. The WGTA officers, cabinet and I have great confidence in Mike.

<u>III.B.1 The Vice President shall:</u> Preside in the absence of the President and shall become President in the event that Officer is unable to serve.

This would create an opening for the office of Vice President. That position can be filled by either a general election or by approval by the Cabinet of a WGTA Member that is submitted by the President. If they are faced with having to provide a transition, the WGTA Cabinet will discuss and approve which of the two procedures to enact.

<u>II.B.2.</u> A vacancy occurring in any office, except that of President, the Cabinet shall authoriz e a specialelection by the general membership or direct the President to submit to the Cabinet for approval the name of the a candidate for the office in which a vacancy exists. A 75% positive vote of those cabinet members present and voting is required for approval. The appointment will terminate at end of the original term.



To have pre-tax dollars placed in an account to pay for childcare or heath costs not covered by insurance, submit the completed documents to the District Office by this date. For more information, see your beginning of the year packet or attend the district's informational session on open enrollment. The plans run January 1 to December 31. These plans help lower your taxable income.

Sabbatical Applications Submitted

BETWEEN FEBRUARY 15 AND MARCH 15, 2018

Individuals interested in taking a sabbatical must submit their application to the Superintendent between the dates of February 15 and March 15. Requirements for taking a Sabbatical Leave include working continuously in the district for seven years, immediately prior to applying. Those on leave maintain full benefits and receive 75% of their salary during a full-year sabbatical. Individuals receive their full salary if taking a half-year sabbatical. Upon returning, individuals must work for the district for two years following the sabbatical.

Sick Bank

PRIOR TO OCTOBER 1st

Our Sick Leave Bank is available to all members. Forms for enrolling in the Sick Leave Bank are available on our website, <u>wgta.net</u>. To join, members must donate two sick days upon their initial enrollment or can enroll at the beginning of any school year, forms must be submitted to Building Secretaries by October 1st. To access the Sick Bank, employees must have used all of their current and prior sick days. I encourage all of our members to seriously consider enrolling to assure that in the unfortunate situation where a member is ill, they are still receiving a salary. The maximum length of a Sick Bank Leave is 90 days. Employees will be paid at the same rate as STEP 1, BA +0 on the salary grid.
