WHAT IS A CRISIS NURSERY?

A Crisis Nursery is a licensed childcare program that provides safe, temporary childcare for children from birth to 5 years old. Crisis Nurseries help parents and caregivers manage emergencies and keep up with jobs, educational programs, and medical treatment.

WHO CAN USE THE CRISIS NURSERIES?



Parents and caregivers who:

- Need childcare while they are in the hospital, a treatment program, or at an appointment
- Need childcare while they look for work, attend an interview, or are on a waiting list to receive subsidized childcare
- Experience stress that may result in the abuse of a child
- Have a family or relationship problem in which safety is a concern

■ Have another kind of emergency
