

# Potted Plant Show

## Junior & Adult

On-line entries will begin August 1<sup>st</sup> and end September 19<sup>th</sup>.

1. Entries accepted on Sunday, Sept. 23 between 1:00-3:00pm or Monday, Sept. 24 between 9:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. Entries will be located in the coliseum. Items can be picked up Sunday September 30 from 12:00-3:00pm.
2. All entries must have been in exhibitor's possession at least 3 months.
3. The containers in which the plant is grown in will not be judged.
4. Ribbons and cash prizes will be awarded. Points will be awarded as follows:

5. All classes will have Junior and Senior divisions. Each plant will be marked to distinguish Junior and Senior entries.
6. If plants are too large to be moved easily by fair management, they will not be accepted.
7. All hanging baskets must be equipped with rings and hooks for hanging. Total length not to exceed 5 feet.

2. Southwest Arkansas District Fair will furnish containers for exhibits.
3. Foliage should have all dust removed.
4. Leaf shine spray is not allowed.
5. Exhibitors must furnish the name of the flower.

7. Ribbons and cash prizes will be awarded. Points will be awarded as follows:
