



Leadership Pocatello-Chubbuck is a program sponsored by the Pocatello-Chubbuck Chamber of Commerce. The program consists of one year of training followed by the “Diplomat” year. This two-year commitment includes leadership training, networking, and interactive tours of leading businesses in each sector of the community – all designed to help optimize community engagement.

Participation in Leadership Pocatello-Chubbuck will also expand your network of business associates and potential customers. You will have the opportunity to interact with new class participants, class facilitators, and Leadership Board members on a monthly basis throughout the first year of participation.
