Pinnebog Teacher Dies At 23

Douglas Arthur Dumaw, 23, Pinnebog, died Friday at Scheurer hospital, Pigeon. Dumaw, who was set to begin his teaching career in the fall, died the day before his 24th birthday. An avid horseman active in area riding circles, Dumaw had been recovering from surgery he underwent recently at Henry Ford Hospital in Detroit.

He was born July 27, 1944 in Bad Axe and lived during his childhood with his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Arthur Dumaw at Pinnebog.

A 1963 graduate of Laker high school, Dumaw graduated from Central Michigan University in 1968 with a bachelor of science degree in education. He was negotiating a tentative contract with the Caro school system at the time of his death.

Douglas Dumaw and Miss Dorothy Schuette were married July 23, 1966 at Pigeon.

Surviving are his widow; his parents; a brother Darel, Kinde; his mother-in-law, Mrs. Ed Schuette, Pigeon; a sister-in-law, Mrs. Ronald Green, Washington D.C. and a number of nieces and nephews.

Remains are at the home of Dumaw's parents in Pinnebog with funeral arrangements being conducted by the MacAlpine funeral home, Bad Axe.

Services will be 2 p.m. Tuesday in the Cross Lutheran church, Pigeon.
