Statement of Purpose

Soundview Knitting Guild is dedicated to:

- Furthering the art of knitting in a social environment,
- Educating all who wish to learn,
- Providing support for all members as they progress and perfect their craft,
- Returning to society the products of our crafts.

History

The Soundview Knitting Guild was founded in Trumbull Connecticut in 1994 with 6 charter members.

Membership

Annual membership dues are \$25, payable in September for full annual membership benefits, which include:

- Membership card which gets you discounts at some local and not-so-local yarn shops.
- Meeting Room rental
- Subsidies for the Holiday party and Spring banquet
- Printing expenses for announcements of party, banquet, etc.
- Mailing expenses for meeting notices sent to those who do not have email addresses
- Hospitality beverages.
- Website hosting

Dues are pro-rated quarterly to accommodate new members during the year:

September through February - \$25; March through May - \$20; June through August - \$10.

In addition to annual dues, there is a monthly meeting fee of \$3. This fee may be paid at each meeting, or the fee for the full year may be paid full September (\$30 for 10 months of meetings at \$3 per meeting – this \$3 fee is not applicable for either the Holiday Party or the Spring Banquet.)

Guests/Potential Members

Guests are encouraged and welcome at all meetings. A guest can attend one meeting free of charge; thereafter, annual membership dues and monthly meeting fees apply. There is only one free meeting per person.

Monthly Meetings

Meetings are held on the Third Wednesday of each month (unless otherwise announced) at the Good Shepherd Lutheran Church, 466 Elm St., Monroe CT. Meeting starts at 7:00 p.m. Members are encouraged to sign up for hospitality and bring a snack to share with the group

Meeting Notices

Meeting notices are sent out monthly via e-mail or the US Postal Service (to the few members who do not have e-mail). Notices are also posted on the Guild's website.

Meeting Cancellation
