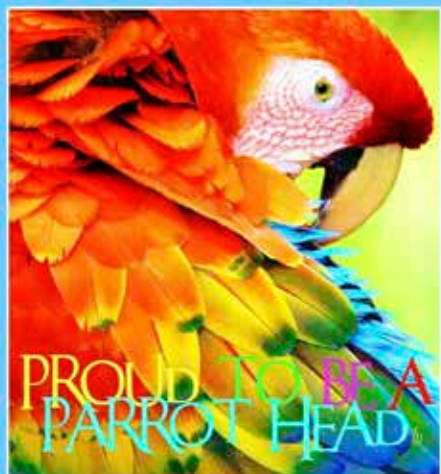

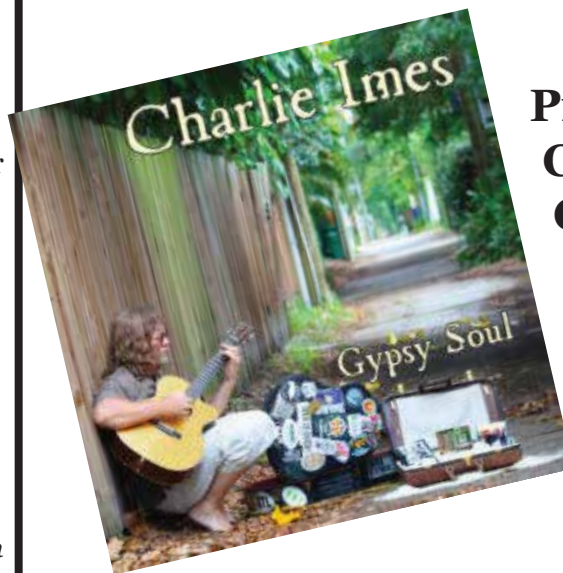

CINCO DE MAYO LAYERED DIP

- 1 can black beans, mashed
- 1/2 envelope taco seasoning
- 1 cup sour cream
- 1 cup chunky salsa
- 8 oz. shredded taco cheese
- 1 cup shredded lettuce
- 6 green onions, sliced thin
- 1/3 cup black olives, sliced
- Fresh cilantro, to taste



Mix beans and taco seasoning. Spread on bottom of 9 inch pie plate. Top with layers of remaining ingredients. Refrigerate for several hours. Serve with Tostitos and Fritos scoops.
