to have tree plans or estimates made up.

## All tree orders are due by December 31st. (Prior to Planting Year)

50% of the cost of the order is due before the order can be placed.

Please note that all Deciduous trees are bare root and come in bundles only. Bundle sizes are shown on the price list. The approximate size of the deciduous trees is stated next to its name, Sizes could vary depending on nursery availability. If you do not see a tree that you want on this list or if you want a different size, ask and we will find out availability for you.

Tree orders will come in during the month of April of the planting year. There is a Minimum Planting Fee of \$150.

The District Guarantees to plant live trees, and does not cover or replace trees that have died due to negligence or wildlife. If your trees have not shown any improvement from the time of planting to September 1st of the planting year, please contact the office and we will work with you if we feel that the trees that were initially planted were not alive.

Any inquires made for replacements after September 1, of the planting year will not be considered.
