



**2018 OPENING ROUND ~ April 21<sup>st</sup> & 22<sup>nd</sup>**

**D-DAY ADVENTURE PARK ~ Wyandotte, OK**

Round 1 of the MORE series kicks off this weekend – April 21/22 – at a new-to-MORE venue ~ D-Day Adventure Park in Wyandotte, OK. If the name sounds familiar, that's because D-Day hosted The Off-Road Cup 9hr race from 2014-2017. It is a perfect dirt bike riding facility.

The terrain is typical “ozarkish” – lots of elevation and gritty/rocky/gravelly “dirt” for the most part. There is some stuff that has minimal rock too, like the areas where the peewee and ladies courses are located.

The 50 course is almost entirely separate from the other courses and runs thru an obstacle course as well as some structures in the “city”. The course is marked with GREEN arrows and ribbon and should be big fun for the kids.

65/85/Ladies split off early from the big course and follows ORANGE/BLACK arrows and PURPLE ribbon. They too will run thru some of the “city” before hitting some single track and going to the Colleville Church and then Pegasus Bridge. No real elevation on this course – just flat fun trails.

The big bike courses will run a mixture of single track and ravines with some wide uphill and dozer roads mixed in. The big bike tracks will change between Saturday and Sunday, so expect some fresh stuff for day two. We are still adding to the Sunday course so mileages will be posted at sign-up.

Keep in mind that this place is rocky & covered in leaves. Be careful while the course is getting “burned in”. There are lots of areas that will only get better as the day goes on.

If you've been here before, you know that the place handles rain probably better than anywhere we go. Much of the trail is actually better when wet...and right now (Wednesday afternoon) there is no water or mud anywhere on the courses, meaning we can use some rain. Parking is good and on top of a hill with a paved road all the way into the property. Don't study the forecast and let the weatherman scare you away.

Concerning directions – they are building new bridges on the normal road we come in on (Cayuga) so we will enter a different way. Follow the directions below or you will be pissy. It's roughly 3 miles different than normal but still good paved road.

From Indigo Sky Casino, go West on Hwy 60 for 4.5 miles. Turn left on Hwy 10 for 1 mile. Turn left on E160 Road for 1.3 miles. Turn right on S670 Road for 0.2 miles. Turn left on 166 Road for 1.3 miles. Turn right on Cayuga Road for 0.2 miles. Turn right on 175 for 0.4 miles into D-Day Adventure Park.

At this time we do not have anyone lined up to do concessions so plan accordingly.

Sign up before you practice – come to the riders' meeting – respect the facility – no riding after dark.

For first-timers to MORE, please take a minute to read through our Rules, and look over our Classes/Numbering lists. Every series does things a little differently than others, so it's important that prior to race day that you are informed. One thing to note is that riders are required to display the appropriate number and background color on all three number plates during our events. If you don't have the correct setup, generics are available at signup for \$3/set of three.

Please make sure that your pets are on a leash at ALL times and remain at your vehicle.
