Several years later, she was able to bring her mother here from Czechoslovakia. Soon after, Hana met and married Norman, and they enjoyed a long life together. leaves behind two sons and their families. For all of us who knew her, we will long remember this special couple as we say, may you rest in peace.

No longer in pain, she will begin physical therapy shortly. **Anita**, we all hope that you will continue to improve each and every day. Your continued positive spirit is amazing!




