


Sunday, August 25th at 12:00 pm

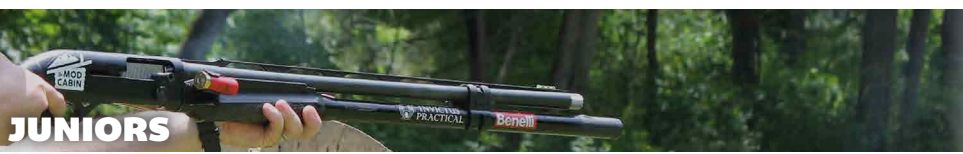
