#### **This Day in History:**

- 2-24 On this day in history in 1868 the house voted to impeach president Andrew Johnson. Johnson violated the "Tenure of Office Act." He was the first president to be impeached in U.S. history. However, the U.S. senate ruled against the impeachment.
- 2-25 On this day in history in 1964 Muhammad Ali won his first world heavy weight title. He beat Sonny Liston who held the title for two years. Muhammad Ali kept the title for 9 years straight.
- 2-26 On this day in history in 1919 congress established the Grand Canyon as a national park. The park was established as a national monument in 1908 by President Theodore Roosevelt and was officially declared a national park in 1919 by President Woodrow Wilson.
- 2-27 On this day in history in 1827 Mardi Gras was celebrated for the first time since Louisiana became a state. The celebrations had previously been banned but residents of New Orleans convinced the city council to lift them.
- 2-28 On this day in history in 1953 the scientist James D. Watson and Francis H.C. Crick announced their discovery of the double helix structure of DNA. This discovery led to a better understanding of how genetics were passed down through the generations.
