#### **Speakers**

- Dr. <u>Kelli Ward</u> wants President Trump to win big in 2020 fighting for God and Country.
  - Reviewing precincts which were not successful in elections
  - AZ GOP has over 4300 PCs now, about 1000 new with room for more (10,000). Wants AZ to be first state in the country to fill Republican PC slots
  - Trump Committee Program onboard those interested in supporting the President, who are potentially good PC candidates. Christine Ong is leading the program for Kelli.
  - Republican voters have majority: 1.3M Reps, 1.1M Dems, 600k
     Libertarians, etc. If everyone just registered one more Republican, we'd be unbeatable!
