Nebraska was +38 ATS points vs Northwestern in a 56-7 win (-11)
The Indiana/Penn St game went UNDER the total by 30 points.
The Duke/North Carolina game went UNDER the total by 29 points.
Bowling Green is 5-0 ATS this year with an average cover margin of 15.9 ppg!
Clemson is 0-5 ATS this year failing to cover the spread by 12.2 ppg!
The OVER is 5-0 in Pitt games going OVER by an average of 18.8 ppg!
The UNDER is 5-0 in Purdue games going UNDER by an average of 17.7 ppg!
Nebraska has covered 5 straight games since losing Illinois in Week Zero.

Misleading Finals

Minnesota upset Purdue 20-13. However, Purdue had 28-12 first down and 448-294 yard edges but were -2 in TO's.

Western Michigan only beat Buffalo 24-17. However, WMU had 29-15 first down and 457-282 yard edges.

Kentucky upset Florida 20-13. However, Florida had a 382-224 yard edge. The key play was a 76-yard blocked FG return for a TD for Kentucky.

Georgia Southern crushed Arkansas St 59-33. However, Arkansas St was only out-gained 540-534 but were -4 in TO's.

Rice beat Southern Miss 24-19. However, Southern Miss had 21-15 first down and 378-315 yard edges but were -4 in TO's.

Middle Tennessee upset Marshall 34-28. However, Marshall had 28-16 first down and 493-314 yard edges but were -4 in TO's. Middle Tennessee got a 91-yard fumble return TD in the 3Q to make it 34-14.

Hawaii upset Fresno St 27-24. It was the most misleading final of the week. Fresno had 31-21 first down and 505-348 yard edges. However they were -5 in TO's and Fresno St's outstanding QB Jake Haener was intercepted three times inside Hawaii's 10-yard line! Hawaii outscored Fresno 17-0 in the fourth quarter. Hawaii won without its starting quarterback, Chevan Cordeiro, who was listed as the expected starter on the team's pre-game depth chart but did not play.

Bad Beats

There weren't a lot bad beats last weekend. Miami money-line backers probably weren't thrilled when the Hurricanes missed a chip-shot FG on the final play vs Virginia. The Memphis/Tulane game had 2 TD's in the final 2:35 that put the game over the total. Kansas St got a 93-yard kick return TD with 1:20 left to back-door Oklahoma that cost us a best bet on these pages. Oregon money-line backers weren't thrilled that several questionable penalties allowed Stanford to score a TD on an untimed down on the final play to force OT where the Cardinal won it there.

Games in Rotation Order Thursday, October 7th

Houston 33 TULANE 28. Houston has won 4 straight and have allowed a total of 37 points in those games. This is Dana Holgorsen's best team and kudos to the Cougars for bouncing back after the opener. Meanwhile, Tulane's season is on the brink after a pair of outright upset losses to UAB and East Carolina the last two weeks. The Green Wave defense is allowing 40 ppg and 482 ypg on the season. Early week money has been on the Cougars and the UNDER. We're sitting this one out.

Coastal Carolina 45 ARKANSAS ST 27. Coastal Carolina comes in at 5-0 albeit against a very weak schedule. The Chanticleers' stats are dominant as they are No. 1 in the country in yards per play margin (+3.7) and No. 2 in the country in ypg margin (+241). QB Grayson McCall was banged up in last week's game but according to early week reports, he will play here. McCall is completing 80% of his passes this year! On the other side, Arkansas St has been a train wreck on defense allowing 46 ppg and 564 ypg this season. The Red Wolves are No. 122 in ypg margin (-1.98). They are the best offense Coastal has seen this season. We bet UNDER 76.5 on the opener along with Arkansas St thinking McCall might not play. Now we pass.

Friday, October 8th

CINCINNATI 41 Temple 14. Cincinnati comes in off arguably their biggest win in school history taking down Notre Dame in South Bend last week. The Bearcats are now playing with playoff pressure down the stretch as they will be significant favorites in their remaining games. Are they flat off such a big win or are they already looking for style points? Meanwhile, Temple is a much improved team this year and are coming off an upset of Memphis as a double-digit underdog. QB Mathis gives them some upside at QB they haven't had in awhile. Our numbers like Cincy here but we like the spot for Temple. Anything north of "+28" is a solid bet on the Owls.

Charlotte 29 FIU 28. FIU comes in off 4 straight losses and last week they were embarrassed by rival FAU allowing 58 points and 704 yards. If things don't improve soon, we're thinking this could be the last year for Butch Davis. Charlotte has certainly exceeded expectations so far this season as they are looking to take a step closer to bowl eligibility. We lean FIU and UNDER.

ARIZONA ST 31 Stanford 20. The Pac-12 is like a box of chocolates where you never know what you're going to get on a weekly basis. Both of these teams come in off upset wins. Stanford got an improbable OT win over Oregon as they had a 0.1% chance to win late in the 4Q according to ESPN's win probability. Several questionable penalties aided their comeback. Meanwhile, Arizona St has to be considered the Pac-12 South favorite now after winning at UCLA. The Sun Devils outscored the Bruins 18-0 in the second half. Slightest of leans on Stanford here but we didn't bet the game on the Sunday openers.

Saturday, October 9th

NORTH CAROLINA 39 Florida St 22. North Carolina has been a "Jekyll and Hyde" team this year with three dominant wins and a pair of upset losses. Last week was "good" North Carolina as they crushed Duke 38-7. Meanwhile, FSU finally notched their first win of the season getting a last-play FG to beat Syracuse. Still, the Noles have failed to cover the spread in 4 straight games. Which North Carolina team will show up here and do they have last year's upset loss to Florida St still on their minds? We lean UNDER.

MICHIGAN ST 29 Rutgers 25. We won with Michigan St on these pages last week. We thought it was going to be an easy one as they led 42-16 at halftime vs WKU but they had to stop the back-door TD late. MSU is No. 18 in the country in yards per play margin (+2.01). Meanwhile, Rutgers comes in off back-to-back defeats and last week their 52-13 loss to Ohio St was arguably their worst performance in two years under Greg Schiano. We like the OVER here. This is the best MSU offense since 2014 but their D is allowing 429 ypg.

Connecticut 30 MASSACHUSETTS 28. Somebody's "O" has got to go! These two teams come in a combined 0-11 and neither has won a game since 2019. It's the resistible force vs the movable object! UMass is No. 129 in the country at -2.65 ypg and are dead last at -247.8 ypg. Meanwhile UConn is No. 126 in at -2.17 ypg and No. 128 at -192.3 ypg. However, the Huskies have shown some signs of life in last-second losses to Wyoming and Vanderbilt the last two weeks. They get the win here but we're not laying more than a FG. We did like OVER 51.5 on the openers.

Wake Forest 31 SYRACUSE 24. The unbeaten Demon Deacons visit the Carrier Dome but their defense has looked shaky the last two weeks allowing more than 500 yards in both contests. They are already 3-0 in conference play and could be 8-0 overall heading to a "non-conference" game at North Carolina in November. Meanwhile, the Orange are much improved this year and nearly upset Florida St last week. Syracuse is +1.63 in ypg margin (No. 26) and we bet them on the openers at +10. Now at the current line of +6.5, we're passing.

CENTRAL FLORIDA 37 East Carolina 28. UCF comes in off a shocking loss at Navy as 15-point favorites. The Knights led 30-17 entering the 4Q but

allowed the game's final 17 points. UCF freshman Mikey Keene, making his first start in place of the injured Dillon Gabriel, was 16-of-26 passing for 178 yards and two TDs. Meanwhile, ECU has won 3 straight and are off their best performance of the season destroying Tulane 52-29 last week. Lean on ECU.

OHIO ST 45 Maryland 21. We're thinking Ohio St might have found something last week in their 52-13 destruction of Rutgers last week. That was the same Rutgers team that almost upset the Wolverines in the Big House the week prior. QB CJ Stroud returned and threw 5 TD passes. The Buckeyes are No. 2 in the country in ypg margin (+3.27). They're taking on a Maryland team that was incredibly -7 in TO's last week in a blowout loss to Iowa. A gruesome injury to leading receiver Dontay Demus seemed to suck the life out of the stadium and we're worried about the Terps here. We like OSU and UNDER.

2★ Akron (plus the points) BOWLING GREEN 28 Akron 20. Bowling Green is now the lone remaining 5-0 ATS team in the country. The Falcons are covering their games by an average of 15.9 ppg and we have upgraded them in our power ratings more than any team in the country this year (see page 6). However, we think you're paying a premium on them here laying more than 2 TD's vs a team that beat them 31-3 last year. Remember, the Falcons were a home underdog to Murray St just a few weeks ago. We like Akron here who were outscored 17-0 in the 4Q vs Ohio last week to create a misleading final score and possibly offer up some value. Do you want to lay more than 2 TD's with an offense that is only averaging 17 ppg?

TOLEDO 34 Northern Illinois 20. After a winless 2020 campaign the Huskies are much improved in 2021 with 3 wins already. They are taking on what we feel is the most talented team in the MAC in Toledo who has rebounded nicely from an upset loss to Colorado St a few weeks ago. The Rockets are No. 30 in the country in yards per play margin (+1.44) while NIU is No. 107 (-0.64). However, this is one of the few games we didn't bet side or total on the openers. Slight leans Toledo and OVER.

KENT ST 31 Buffalo 27. Kent St gets a lot of publicity for their fast tempo (No. 11 in plays per game this year). However, the UNDER is 5-0 in their games cashing by an average of 12.8 ppg. They have played a tough schedule including Texas A&M, Iowa and Maryland. Meanwhile, Buffalo has lost 3 of their last 4 and were very fortunate in that lone win vs Coastal Carolina. Are the Bulls who lost a ton of players from their 2-deep and hired an entirely different coaching staff after spring starting to feel those impacts? Our numbers like them here but we prefer the UNDER.

Georgia Tech 32 DUKE 28. Two teams that need a win if they're going to have any bowl aspirations this season. Both come in off blowout losses in conference play as Duke was crushed by rival North Carolina 38-7 and Georgia Tech couldn't stop a high-powered Pitt offense in a 52-21 loss. We thought there was going to be some value on the OVER in this game but the markets are all "over" it. Pass.

WESTERN MICHIGAN 31 Ball St 21. After a blowout loss to Michigan in the opener, this Western Michigan team has played as well as any Group of 5 team in the country. That's 4 straight wins including an upset over a good Pitt team. Meanwhile, Ball St might have turned their season around with an upset over Army last week. The Cardinals raced out to a 21-0 1Q lead and then hung on. It was their first cover of the season. We lean UNDER as Western Michigan's games vs Michigan and Pitt are offering value. Their D has allowed just 20 total points and 458 total yards in their other 3 games combined!

LIBERTY 37 Middle Tennessee 19 Liberty is coming off by far their best performance of the season. After an upset loss to Syracuse, the Flames found themselves tied at UAB 3-3 at halftime only to outscore the Blazers 33-9 in the second half! QB Malik Willis has thrown 11 TD passes with ZERO interceptions this season and is by far the leading rusher with 418 yards and 6 TD's. He's a first-round pick in our opinion. They're taking on a Middle Tennessee team that is fresh off a misleading upset over Marshall last week. The Blue Raiders were outgained by nearly 200 yards and were +4 in TO's. Reality will settle in here. We bet UNDER 64.5 on the opener and still lean that way.

LOUISVILLE 33 Virginia 31. An underrated game in the ACC here between two teams who are looking to rebound after sub-par 2020 seasons. Virginia's season could have been saved with that missed Miami FG last Thursday. It would have been 3 straight losses for them. Meanwhile, Louisville is off a close loss to Wake Forest as QB Cunningham already has 10 TD runs and a 7-2 TD-to-INT ratio. Two underrated QB's and two questionable defenses. Still, we think this total is too high. We lean UNDER here.

AIR FORCE 24 Wyoming 19. 4-0 Wyoming comes in off a bye. The Cowboys have played a really easy schedule so far and last time we saw them they nearly lost outright as 31.5-point favorites to Connecticut. Meanwhile, Air Force is a bit underrated. They are one bad 4Q away vs Utah St from being 5-0. They scored a little too much last week on these pages in their dominating 38-10 win over New Mexico (we had UNDER). Despite being an option team, Air Force is +0.94 in yards per play (No. 41). We lean UNDER as 10 of the last 13 meetings have easily gone UNDER.

BYU 30 Boise St 24. Who will play QB for the Cougars here? We thought we were on our way to an easy winner on these pages last week. However, 2nd string QB Baylor Romney was hurt on the final play of first half. He was making his second consecutive start with starter Jaren Hall sidelined because of a rib injury. Third-string QB Jacob Conover led the offense after halftime. It was the first football game Conover had played in 3.5 years! Meanwhile, Boise St is reeling at 2-3. The Broncos are -0.44 in yards per play margin (No. 102) and have been outgained on the season. We bet BYU -3 and UNDER 57.5 on the openers but need further clarification on the BYU QB situation.

MARSHALL 42 Old Dominion 22. The Thundering Herd come in with 3 straight losses including two as a double-digit favorite. Last week they out-gained Middle Tennessee by 179 yards but were -4 in TO's. Meanwhile, ODU has been more competitive than we anticipated this season but still the Monarchs are 1-4 and have a tough conference schedule ahead of them. Marshall gets a bounce-back win here but we're not comfortable laying 3 TD's.

3★ COLORADO ST 26 San Jose St 20. We like Colorado St. The Rams started 0-2 but they lost to the best FCS team in the country in South Dakota St in the opener. Keep in mind, South Dakota St's power rating would have them rated better than half the teams in the FBS! Then the Rams somehow lost to Vanderbilt despite out-gaining them by more than 100 yards. Colorado St got an impressive win over a good Toledo team and then gave Iowa all they could handle. They're heading in the right direction and now they come in fresh off a bye. They're taking on a banged up San Jose St team that has played their two worst games of the season the last two weeks. That includes a close win over a hapless New Mexico St team. San Jose is probably without QB Nick Starkel again.

USC 29 Utah 25. Two teams that have vastly underachieved so far this season. Utah is 2-2 and already seen their starting QB quit the team. They are also dealing with another tragic player death...this time Aaron Lowe who was wearing the No. 22 this season to honor his friend Ty Jordan (Utah's leading rusher) who also tragically died last year. Utah didn't practice during the bye week so we don't know what their mind-set here is. The same could be said for USC who has already fired their coach Clay Helton and has been "Jekyll and Hyde" the last four games. We bet OVER 48.5 on the Sunday openers.

Oregon St 30 WASHINGTON ST 27. Oregon St got a ton of money in the market last week and that proved correct as they beat Washington 27-24. That's now 4 straight wins as their ground game has averaged 267 ypg in those wins. They're taking on a Washington St team that is off their best performance of the season, a 21-6 win at Cal as 7.5-point underdogs. The Beavers are No. 34 in the country in ypp margin (+1.35) while Washington St is No. 98 (-0.35). We bet UNDER 63.5 on the openers and don't see much value in the side.

TENNESSEE 32 South Carolina 23. Both teams have first year coaches and we think both have exceeded expectations so far. The winner here takes a major step towards bowl eligibility, something neither has seen much as of late. Tennessee had one of the more dominant performances by any team in any game last week. They covered the spread by 40.5-points at Missouri as they piled up 458 rushing yards in the 62-24 win. Hendon Hooker (69%, 10-1 ratio) looks like a clear upgrade over Joe Milton (47%, 1-0 ratio) who started the first few games of the season. We lean South Carolina here as they will have to control game clock to keep Tennessee's offense off the field.

2★ OVER 55.5 SMU 39 Navy 23. Navy's offense has been much improved the last few games after firing their OC (Jasper is still on staff coaching QB's). The Middies got a big outright upset win as 15-point underdogs last week outscoring UCF 17-0 in the fourth quarter. Navy ran for 348 yards, their most since 2019. Meanwhile, SMU's offense is rolling averaging 43 ppg and 533 ypg. The OVER has cashed in 5 of the last 6 meetings each of those games going over this total. Last year's game was 51-37. The average total score in the last 6 meetings is 78.3 ppg.

Tcu 31 TEXAS TECH 30. We think this TCU program is living off past success under head coach Gary Patterson. The Horned Frogs are 0-3-1 ATS this year and are on a 26-39-1 ATS run dating back to 2016. Their once-proud defense is allowing 204 rushing ypg this year. They're taking on a Texas Tech team that is much improved this year and last week scored a surprising upset of West Virginia as 7.5-point underdogs. Considering they lost by 35 to Texas the week prior and were playing without several starters, we faded the Red Raiders on the VIP update and got our teeth kicked down our throat. We're passing.

GEORGIA 30 Auburn 16. The Bulldogs have been so impressive this year especially on the defensive side where they are putting up historical numbers. So far they are allowing 5 ppg and 181 ypg. Georgia is No. 1 in the country out-gaining their opponents by 254 ypg. It hasn't mattered who is behind center as they have the deepest RB corps in the country. We already can't wait for the SEC Championship game vs Alabama (yes, we think that match-up is a very safe bet). On the other side, Auburn QB Bo Nix had one of the best performances out any QB in any game this year last week. He willed the Tigers to come-from-behind win at LSU (first win there since 1999). For all the grief he gets, Nix hasn't thrown an interception this season. He will be up against here. Our numbers like Auburn but we're not stepping in front of Georgia here.

KENTUCKY 27 Lsu 26. LSU is one of our strongest power ratings' plays of the week and we have yet to bet them...why? Two words...Ed Orgeron! Yes, he's won a National Championship but that season looks like the big out-lier. LSU is averaging just 71 rushing ypg this year! That's unacceptable. Meanwhile, Kentucky is off one of their biggest wins in recent memory as they beat Florida at home for the first time since 1986. It was a misleading game as they were outgained by 158 yards and returned a blocked FG for a TD (10-point swing). We need "+3.5" to show back up for us to bet the Tigers.

BAYLOR 24 West Virginia 23. West Virginia's loss to a short-handed Texas Tech team was one of the biggest disappointments of last week on our VIP update. Now you look at West Virginia's schedule and you have to question if the Mountaineers can even make a bowl game. It starts against a much improved Baylor team that lost their first game of the season last week at Oklahoma St. The Bears are notably No. 6 in the country in yards per play margin at +2.47 but that came against a very weak slate to start the season. We thought the opening total was way too low and bet OVER 41.5.

MISSOURI 40 North Texas 21. Missouri has now failed to cover in 8 straight games dating back to last season (-12.3 ppg). Last week's 62-24 loss vs Tennessee saw Missouri fail to cover the spread by 40.5-points! Their rush defense this season ranks among the worst we've ever seen at the Power 5 level as they are now allowing 307 rushing ypg. Keep in mind, the Tigers are not playing 1995 Nebraska every week in the Big 8! They do get a break vs a bad North Texas team who comes in off a bye. The UNDER is 4-0 in North Texas games this year going UNDER by an average of 18.1 ppg. That's why we bet UNDER.

South Alabama 27 TEXAS ST 25. South Alabama beat us on these pages last week in their near upset over UL-Lafayette. We have to admit, we thought we had a winner when ULL was up 20-0 in the first 20 minutes of the game but SA fought back. The Jaguars are a respectable +0.47 in yards per play margin this year (No. 68). They're taking on a Texas St team off a bye. The Bobcats have been really disappointing this year and are -1.39 in yards per play margin (No. 118). We bet UNDER 57 on the open but would pass at the current number.

UAB 28 Florida Atlantic 22. It had to be one of the biggest disappointments of last week. UAB was playing their first game in a brand new stadium. They were tied at 3-3 at halftime against a good UAB team. And then they were crushed in the second half losing 36-12. Meanwhile, we get a FAU team off their best performance of the season in crushing rival FIU 58-21. The Owls put up 704 yards! It will be tougher sledding this week against this UAB defense. We think the Blazers bounce back.

FLORIDA 45 Vanderbilt 10. All those good feelings about Florida's season went up in smoke last Saturday night as the Gators lost at Kentucky for the first time since 1986. The Gators had a 382-224 yard edge but a blocked FG returned for a TD (10-point swing) was the key play. Now they take on a hapless Vanderbilt team that was fortunate to beat lowly Connecticut last week. Right now, the Commodores are the lowest-rated SEC team we've ever had in our power ratings. We'll be absolutely stunned if they can win another game.

TULSA 32 Memphis 28. Both teams' seasons are on the brink. Memphis has lost back-to-back games outright as a favorite including last week 34-31 at Temple (-11). The Tigers are still No. 33 in the country in yards per play margin (+1.36). Meanwhile, Tulsa at 1-4 was just blown out at home to Houston. They are +0.59 in ypp despite playing a tough schedule. We're passing.

Georgia St 33 UL-MONROE 17. Georgia St followed up their near upset of Auburn with a dud last week as they were crushed by Appalachian St. At 1-4, they need a feel-good win to make a run at their 3rd straight bowl appearance. They'll get it here vs a ULM team that despite a 2-2 record is dead last in the country in yards per play margin (-3.46) and are -234.7 ypg (No. 129). They played last week with a backup QB in a 59-6 loss to Coastal Carolina and could again here as starter Rhett Rodriguez remains questionable.

Wisconsin 27 ILLINOIS 16. Wisconsin is easily one of the 5 most disappointing teams in 2021. They are 1-3 for the first time since 1990 which was Barry Alvarez' first year. The Badgers have played a really tough schedule so far with losses to 3 Top 15 teams in Penn St, Notre Dame and Michigan and will be taking a step down in class here. The question is will QB Graham Mertz play? He was questionable on the latest injury report. The major story-line is former Wisconsin head coach Brett Bielema plays against his former team. We haven't been overly impressed with Illinois since their upset over Nebraska in the opener. In fact, we feel questionable coaching decisions by Bielema have cost them possible wins vs Maryland and Purdue. We laid -8 on the opener because our numbers told us too but it wasn't our favorite bet.

EASTERN MICHIGAN 27 Miami, Oh 26. Our ratings say the wrong team is favored here. Both teams have similar stat lines with EMU No. 77 in ypp margin while Miami, Oh is No. 79. We think the Eagles bounce back after losing at Northern Illinois last week. They were +50 in yards. Meanwhile, Miami, Oh opened up their MAC season with a win over Central Michigan. EMU is on a 26-8-2 ATS run as an underdog! We wouldn't be surprised if they flipped favorite in this one just like what happened in last week's game vs NIU. We also like the UNDER here.

† Oklahoma 31 Texas 30. @Cotton Bowl in Dallas, TX. Texas has covered 7 of the last 9 in the series. One of those ATS losses was last year in a 4OT loss but it should be noted the Horns were covering at the end of regulation. Texas has not been favored in the series since 2009 and aren't again here this year. However, if we were just going off recent performances, they probably should be favored as Texas is 4-1 ATS this year while the Sooners are 0-4 ATS vs FBS competition. Last week the Sooners should have covered vs Kansas St but a 93-yard kick return TD with 1:20 left did them in (much to our dismay on these pages). It was one of their better performances and we're wondering if QB Spencer Rattler finally regained some confidence (22 of 25 last week). We have leans on Texas and the UNDER.

Michigan 27 NEBRASKA 23. Obviously, Michigan has been super impressive this season with only one bad half (2H vs Rutgers) of football. They are 4-1 ATS on the season with an average cover margin of 13.4 ppg. The Wolverines are also +2.2 in yards per play margin (No. 11) and are up to No. 6 in our power ratings. On the other side, it looks like the market threw the Cornhuskers in the trash after losing outright to Illinois in the opener. Since then, Nebraska the Huskers have 5 straight covers by 13.6 ppg. Their 56-7 blowout win over Northwestern last week was one of their most impressive performances in several years. The Huskers covered the spread by 38 points. They are now +1.83 in yards per play margin (No. 21) and are +182 ypg (No. 7). Believe it or not, but Nebraska is up to No. 20 in our power ratings. Still, it should be noted that Nebraska is just 5-15 straight up under Scott Frost in games decided by one possession (8 points or less). We bet Michigan (-2) and UNDER 53.5 on the openers but don't see as much value now.

2★ TROY 30 Georgia Southern 21. We like Troy in this one. We think their rush defense that is allowing just 98 rush ypg and 2.7 yards per carry will slow down Georgia Southern's rush attack. On top of that, we think Georgia Southern's 59-33 blowout win over Arkansas St was a bit fluky as the Eagles were +4 in TO's. Teams usually get a one-game bump with an interim coach but we'll see if it can carry over here. Both teams are 2-3 straight up but Georgia Southern is -1.31 in yards per play margin (No. 115) and -101.6 ypg (No. 118) while Troy is +0.72 in ypp (No. 52) and +74 ypg (No. 48).

Central Michigan 29 OHIO 25. Did Ohio finally find something last week in that 4Q vs Akron. The Bobcats had been 0-4 ATS and were tied with Akron 17-17 but outscored the Zips 17-0 in the final stanza to pick up their first win of the season. Meanwhile, CMU could be playing without QB Daniel Richardson (8-0 ratio) here as he banged up his shoulder last week. It should be noted that Jacob Simron was the starter earlier this year but has struggled (6-4 ratio). We lean with the Bobcats.

Alabama 35 TEXAS A&M 16. Obviously, this game doesn't have the same hype we thought it would have at the start of the season. Obviously, the No. 2 Crimson Tide have done their part. Last week, when the whole world seemed to be on Ole Miss, Alabama jumped out to a 28-0 halftime lead and won 42-21. Bama RB Brian Robinson rushed for career highs of 171 yards and four touchdowns and Nick Saban improved to 24-0 against his former assistants. Obviously, Jimbo is another one of Saban's former assistants and the Aggies have been one of the most disappointing teams in 2021. Their offense is only averaging 19 ppg the last 4 games. and now their defense has allowed 441 ypg the last two weeks. How do they keep up?

OLE MISS 35 Arkansas 27. Both teams were involved in high-profile games last week and both came away humbled in blowout losses. Arkansas was shut out by Georgia 37-0 as QB KJ Jefferson continues to be banged up. Both teams still rank in the Top 20 in yards per play and yards per game margins. However, we think this is a redemption game for Ole Miss QB Matt Corral who threw 6 interceptions in last year's loss to Arkansas. We bet Ole Miss -3 on the openers and also like the UNDER. Note we think Arkansas could be a little worn out playing their 3rd straight big game while Ole Miss had a bye prior to Alabama.

Utep 24 SOUTHERN MISS 23. If you're wondering why Southern Miss is a home underdog to UTEP, it's because the Golden Eagles are down to a 3rd string QB in Jake Lange. Lange moved the team last week in throwing for 304 yards in the loss at Rice but also threw 3 costly interceptions. Meanwhile, they're taking on a UTEP team that is 4-1 this season and has to be thinking bowl game for the first time since 2014. The Miners are +1.01 in yards per play margin which is No. 40 in the country. Their QB Gavin Hardison was also banged up a bit but it looks like he will play here. Keep an eye on big play WR Jacob Cowing who is averaging 24.4 yards per catch. Our ratings like Southern Miss here but maybe we didn't downgrade enough at QB. This game will tell us a lot about Southern Miss moving forward.

3★ OVER 69.5 Utsa 38 WESTERN KENTUCKY 37. The wise guys love this WKU team. Don't believe us? How about a 1-3 WKU team being favored by over a FG vs a 5-0 UTSA team? We did fade WKU last week on these pages and cashed. However, even though Michigan St led 42-16 at halftime, we still had to sweat out a possible back-door cover TD. WKU, despite a tough schedule is +1.74 in yards per play margin (No. 23 in the country). Meanwhile, UTSA might have been too busy celebrating their win over Memphis last week as they barely beat UNLV. We do like UTSA here as sometimes the market gets too cute with these analytic darlings. What we do love is that WKU games are 4-0 to the OVER this year by an average of 14.3 ppg. They're a completely different team than the last two years that saw their games average 44 and 45 total ppg.

IOWA 21 Penn St 20. Raise your hand if you had this game as one of the biggest games of the CFB season? We did have both in the Top 25 of our preseason ratings including Penn St No. 9 but certainly didn't expect this to be a match-up of Top 5 teams. Last week Iowa benefitted from +7 TO's in a blowout win over Maryland. The Hawkeyes are only +0.68 in yards per play margin (No. 53) and +48.6 in ypg (No. 61). Still, they only allow 87 rushing ypg and 12 ppg on defense. Penn St also allows only 12 ppg on defense this year but are more explosive with a +1.88 yards per play margin (No. 20) and are +104.4 in ypg (No. 36). We need a "+3" to show to be involved though.

VIRGINIA TECH 24 Notre Dame 23. We like the spot here for Virginia Tech who is coming off a bye while Notre Dame is playing a 6th straight week and is off physical games vs Wisconsin and Cincinnati. Notre Dame is only averaging 81 rushing ypg and now take on a Hokies' defense that is giving up just 15 ppg on the season. Remember, VT got after a poor North Carolina offensive line in the opener sacking Sam Howell 6 times. No matter who starts at QB for Notre Dame, their offensive line stinks allowing 22 sacks this season. Hokies outright!

Ucla 37 ARIZONA 20. Arizona is one of only four winless teams in the FBS right now. The Wildcats have actually lost 16 straight games dating

back to the 2019 season. They did play Oregon tough in their last game as they only trailed 24-19 in the 4Q but were done in by a -5 TO margin. Meanwhile, the Bruins were shockingly handled by Arizona St last week getting outscored 18-0 in the second half. With two losses at home in their last 3 games, it might be nice for Chip Kelly and Company to hit the road. We lean UNDER here.

SAN DIEGO ST 31 New Mexico 11. New Mexico DC Rocky Long returns to San Diego St where he was the coach from 2011-2019 piling up a 81-38 record with 3 conference championships and a bowl appearances in all 9 years. San Diego St is 4-0, ranked and coming off a bye. New Mexico looks like they need a bye. The Lobos are 0-5 ATS on the season and have failed to cover those games by 11.6 ppg. We're not fond of laying nearly 3 TD's with a total in the low 40's.

NEVADA 44 New Mexico St 14. The Wolf Pack come in off a big win at Boise St last week. Nevada, the pre-season favorite to win the Mountain West Conference's West division, snapped a six-game losing streak to the Broncos, dating back to 2010. Nevada last won in Boise in 1997. They're taking on a New Mexico St team that has been exceeding expectations as of late with 4 covers in their last 5 games. They only lost by 6 at San Jose St last week as 25-point underdogs. Still, this is their 7th straight week playing while Nevada had a bye prior to Boise. We lean UNDER.

Friday, October 8th

Appalachian St 27 UL-LAFAYETTE 24. There is no line at press-time on this game. App St has been the more impressive team with a +1.21 ypp (No. 36) and +116.6 ypg (No. 25) margins while ULL is +0.03 (No. 82) and -15.8 ypg (No. 93) despite a 4-1 record.

For the past five seasons we have posted computer projected lines for every game. **Games where there was of difference of more than 3 points saw our computer lines actually beat the Vegas line at a 373-302-12 (55%) including an outstanding 71-50 (59%) last year! Last week's plays went 3-7 and are 24-25 on the season.** That's still pretty solid and actually better than our own handicapping in some seasons. Keep in mind, these computer lines don't take into consideration off-the-field factors like revenge or flat spots. They are basically a power-rating number difference between the two teams that also takes into consideration the home field advantage.

Of the 10 games where our computer is off more than 3 points compared to the Vegas line (highlighted), our favorite team this week to back would be **Akron +14.5**.

The Comp column is the computer projected line and the Diff column is the difference between the Vegas line and the Computer line. "+" numbers in the difference column say back the underdog. "-" numbers in the difference column say back the favorite. Let us know if you have questions.

TAMPA BAY 28 Miami 18. The Dolphins season took a major turn for the worse last week as they were shutdown by a winless Indianapolis team. Miami managed just 203 yards of offense. Meanwhile the Bucs come off the emotional win in New England. They have to feel fortunate to be 3-1 winning a couple of last-second games. We haven't been overly impressed with them so far as they are 1-3 ATS and are banged up. We lean UNDER.

CAROLINA 26 Philadelphia 21. Carolina comes in off their first loss of the season. Still, Sam Darnold is the first Carolina QB to pass for 300 or more yards in 3 straight games. He should have success against a Philadelphia defense that has allowed 40 or more points in back-to-back weeks for the first time in 55 years. They are the most penalized team in the NFL and we think Carolina has a big coaching edge here.

2★ New Orleans 24 WASHINGTON 20. Two teams had disparate results last week. New Orleans comes in off an OT loss to the Giants where they blew an 11-point lead with 7:00 left. Meanwhile Washington scored 2 late TD's to come-from-behind and beat Atlanta 34-30. It was the Football Team's 2nd close win of the season and they could easily be 0-4. We like the Saints here to get a bounce back win. Note they are No. 7 in DVOA (a respected advanced analytic metric).

2★ Tennessee 28 JACKSONVILLE 21. Tennessee comes in off the shocking loss to the Jets in OT. Money poured in against Tennessee all week as the Titans came in banged up especially at WR with Julio Jones and AJ Brown out. Meanwhile, the Jags are 0-4 straight up and that's the least of their problems as Urban Meyer is once again making news off the field. We don't see him in Jacksonville beyond this year and we don't think he's respected at all in the locker-room. We like Tennessee to get a bounce back win.

MINNESOTA 28 Detroit 18. It looks like the sports books are starting to implement some teaser protection as this line has gone up to 9. Minnesota cashed for us on the teasers last week on these pages but they still took a home loss to move to 1-3 on the season. They need a bounce back win vs a 0-4 Detroit team. The Lions made history again last week and of course for the wrong reason. They became the first team in nearly 3 decades to score ZERO points despite 3 straight trips inside Chicago's 10-yard line on their first 3 possessions. Minnesota has won 7 straight in the series while going 6-1 ATS. More of the same. We lean UNDER.

PITTSBURGH 21 Denver 19. After suffering 3 straight losses, the Steelers really need a win here or head coach Mike Tomlin's run of 14 straight non-losing seasons will be coming to an end. It looks like the end for QB Big Ben. The Broncos were overrated considering their 3 wins came against the Giants, Jags and Jets. They were exposed last week vs Baltimore and more concerning was QB Teddy Bridgewater

suffering a concussion. Predictably Drew Lock couldn't do much in relief (12 of 21 for 113 yards and an INT). We really like Pittsburgh here if Teddy can't go but as of press-time his status is unknown.

Green Bay 26 CINCINNATI 25. The Packers come in off 3 straight wins as Aaron Rodgers has a 9-to-0 TD-to-INT ratio in those games. However, we think this could be a flat spot for them here. It also doesn't help that their premier pass rusher Za'Darius Smith remains out and their shutdown CB Jaire Alexander could also be missing. Meanwhile, 3-1 Cincy has extra time to prep after a come-from-behind win over Jacksonville last Thursday. Joe Burrow gets the headlines but the Cincinnati defense is much improved and are No. 7 in scoring D and total D. To the wire.

New England 23 HOUSTON 13. Hate to say it but we think Belichick blew that game last week vs Tampa. They probably should have went for it instead of trying a 56-yard FG in the rain. Meanwhile, the Texans had 4 total yards in the first half last week vs Buffalo. What a far cry from what they had offensively with Tyrod Taylor the first two weeks. Davis Mills should still be in college and has no business being an NFL starter. Meanwhile, the Patriots rookie QB Mac Jones looks comfortable and at one point had 19 straight completions last week. We lean UNDER which is 4-0 in New England games this year.

LAS VEGAS 26 Chicago 20. Chicago's Khalil Mack takes on his former team in what was a shocking trade three years ago. Chicago just announced this morning that Justin Fields will be their starting QB moving forward. The Raiders come in off the MNF loss to the Chargers as we cashed fading them on these pages. They are 2-0 at home this year but both wins have come in OT. We lean with the Raiders.

L.A. CHARGERS 26 Cleveland 24. A possible preview match-up in the playoffs this year. Both teams come in at 3-1. Cleveland does have the No. 1 rush offense in the NFL but it's been the Cleveland's defense that has been outstanding their 3-game win streak allowing just 11 ppg. They'll get their toughest test though since Week 1 vs Justin Herbert and Company though. The Browns are making back-to-back road trips while the Chargers are at home for a 2nd straight week. We cashed with the Chargers at home on MNF and we lean Chargers and OVER.

DALLAS 28 N.Y. Giants 22. Don't look now but the only 4-0 ATS team in the NFL is Dallas. The Cowboys have exceeded expectations by 8.4 ppg so far this season. They're also playing a 3rd straight road game while the Giants are on back-to-back road trips. The Giants won their first game of the season last week in OT at New Orleans scoring the game's final 17 points. New York is an impressive 18-4 ATS as a road underdog. We need to see a "+7.5" though to take them here.

3★ San Fran (plus the points) ARIZONA 26 San Francisco 24. This a classic "Buy Low, Sell High" spot. Don't look now but the Cardinals are the last remaining unbeaten team in the NFL. They had one of their better performances in recent team history last week beating the Rams 37-20. They have scored at least 30 points in every game this season. On the other side, the 49ers are off back-to-back home losses. We're not sure at press-time who will be the starter for SF as rookie Trey Lance obviously gives them a different dimension than Jimmy G who is dealing with a calf injury. We're not sure Lance is that big of a downgrade as the look-ahead line was Arizona -2.5 and the Westgate summer line on this game was "Pick". The 49ers are also 15-8 ATS as road dogs under Shanahan.

KANSAS CITY 28 Buffalo 27. Obviously, this is a rematch of last year's AFC Championship game and could be a preview of another playoff match-up. The Bills have won 3 straight games in dominant fashion. Their 40-0 win over Houston last week was the single best defensive performance according to DVOA (analytics site) since 1983 by any team! Obviously, they will have their work cut out for them here vs a KC offense that is averaging 33.5 ppg. Last week the Chiefs got only their second cover in their last 15 games! Meanwhile the Bills are 12-3 ATS in their last 15 games. KC has played the tougher schedule but right now we lean with Buffalo.

Monday, October 11th

BALTIMORE 26 Indianapolis 20. The Colts got their first win of the season last week winning at Miami. That snapped their longest losing streak in 10 years. Obviously, this is a much taller order vs a Baltimore team that has won 3 straight and dominated Denver last week. They ran a play with :03 left to make sure their 100-yard rushing streak got to 43 straight games. We have a slight lean on the dog here as the Ravens might be in a flat spot even though its MNF. Remember the opener was in OT at Las Vegas, they had a thrilling win over KC, a 66-yard FG as time expired at Detroit and then a dominating win over a 3-0 Denver team.
