Dear Parents & Guardians,

Once again, I want to thank you so much for your continued efforts in helping us to team teach your children. Teachers, students and families have been very busy! Good News—The end is in sight!!!!

The governor spoke on May 6, and together with the Archdiocese of Washington, the decision has been made continue to keep our school campus closed. The last day of school for OLSS will be June 2, 2020. The plan for closing the school year is as follows:

- Teachers will email the last week of new work on May 17, with the completion date of May 22.
- May 25 is Memorial Day and will be a holiday.
- May 26 - 29 will be Family Prep/Catch up days. Students will finish/ present final projects and book reports, have final ZOOM meetings and be given time to complete all unfinished work. You will be asked to help your student(s) gather and label all their homework and assignments to be turned in to teachers to be graded and to clean, uncover and sanitize textbooks to be returned to school.
- June 1 - 5 will be "Turn In days". You will need to schedule an appointment (much like a report card conference) to come to school and return all your student's belongings (more information on this to come).

I also want to apologize for having to cancel the Family Parade. Upon further reflection and recommendation from local law enforcement, it seemed better and safer to hold off on our Parade until the Governor lifts the Stay at Home Order. You all are still in our hearts and we miss our students very much.

This has been an exceptionally challenging year and I am so grateful that we have gotten through it together!!! The OLSS community is the BEST!!!! Stay happy, healthy and holy!

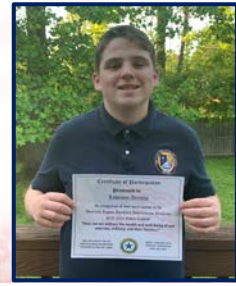
